**Group Discussion Guide**

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**Opening Reflection:**

*Read Hebrews 10:11-25 aloud as a group. Take a moment to reflect on what stands out to you in this passage*

1. How do you reconcile the idea of being “perfected” and still in the process of “being sanctified/being/made holy”? What hope does this give you in your walk with God?
  
2. What holds people back from approaching God confidently? How can we grow in our boldness to draw near to Him?
  
3. What does it look like to practically “hold fast” to hope in the face of doubt, delay, or difficulty? Discuss what God promises us.
  
4. How do shame or guilt sometimes interfere with our relationship with God? What helps you rest in the cleansing Christ offers?
  
5. Who in your life has stirred you toward love and good deeds? How can you intentionally encourage someone else this week?
  
6. Why do you think community is emphasized so strongly here? In what ways can we strengthen each other as we look toward Christ’s return?
  
7. Pastor Doug shared in the message that "God's faith in us matters more than our faith in God." What does that say/mean to you?

**Action Step for the Week:**

**Pick one person in your faith community to intentionally encourage this week. Write a note, make a call, or speak life into someone who might need a reminder of God’s grace and the hope we have in Jesus. Bonus challenge: stir them toward love or a good work!**
