Group Discussion Guide

Opening Reflection:

Read Hebrews 11 as a group. Take a moment to reflect on what stands out to you in this passage:

Hebrews 11 – “Living by Faith” Discussion Questions

1. **What stands out to you about how Hebrews 11 defines faith in verse 1?**
How does that definition challenge or encourage your current understanding of faith?

2. **Which person’s story of faith in Hebrews 11 speaks to you the most right now — and why?**

3. **Many of the people listed never saw the fulfillment of God’s promises in their lifetime (v.13, v.39).**
What does that teach us about trusting God with long-term outcomes?

4. **Some of the faith stories (like Abraham’s or Moses’) involve huge risks and uncertain outcomes.**
What’s one area in your life where God might be calling you to step out in faith — even if it’s scary?

5. **Why do you think God included such a wide variety of people — from patriarchs to former prostitutes — in this chapter?**
What does that tell us about who God chooses and uses?

6. **Hebrews 11:6 says, “Without faith it is impossible to please God.”**
What does pleasing God through faith look like in everyday decisions and relationships?

Challenge for the Week:

Choose one situation in your life where you’re tempted to rely on control, fear, or comfort instead of faith.

This week, take one small but bold step of trust — whether it’s praying instead of over-planning, speaking hope where you usually stay silent, or saying “yes” to something God’s been prompting you to do.
