## 21 Days of Fasting and Prayer



It's the beginning of another year, but not just any year ... this is our 30th Anniversary. I have been asking myself the question, "God, what do you want to do in me and through me this year?" It is a little scary to ask that question. Most of the time I am content with things just as they are. But, there are moments when I experience a holy discontentment. There is a longing and aching in me for more of God. I want to see His glory, overwhelmed by His presence and consumed by His love. I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might ... Ephesians 1:16–19
