CONNECT

What is the conversation that, when you hear it being discussed, you can't help but contribute your opinion or knowledge? Share about a time when you jumped into a conversation of this circumstance.



ENGAGE

Read Acts 4:29-30 & Acts 5:17-42

- 1. In verse 4:29, what were the threats to the first followers of Jesus? What is the "word" to speak with boldness?
- 2.In verse 4:30, who is the name by which healing and wonders are accomplished?
- 3. In verse 5:20, what is the angel asking the Apostles to speak?
- 4. In verse 5:29, what does Peter's response tell us about the authority of Jesus?
- 5. William Reed made the point that the movement of God through us starts with an obedient, "Yes!" When you were quiet, in prayer, what did you sense from the Lord? Who or where you you called to practice boldness with "your word"? What does saying, "Yes!" mean to you in your life.



PRAY

Pray together in your group for boldness--specifically boldness in the areas and with the people you identified in answer to the questions in 5 above.

PRACTICE

Practicing God's gift of prayer language – sounds and verbalizations that help you grow closer to Jesus' promised presence.

- Quiet yourself (mind, body, and spirit) before God. Ready yourself to listen.
- 2 Ask God to fill you afresh with the Holy Spirit.
- Open your mouth and with your voice release the sounds and syllables that come naturally.
- Note the verbalizations that repeat and press into these expressions. Continue.
