On January 11th at 4pm, we will have a town hall meeting where the Personnel Committee will share information about the candidate, talk about the process, and answer questions. On January 17th from 9-11am, we will have a meet and greet time where you can meet the candidate and hear his heart for worship and family ministries. Then on January 18th, he will lead the singing portion of our worship service and there will be a vote by the church members at the conclusion of the service about whether to call him as a pastor to serve in this role.

I am excited to see what the Lord has in store for Heartland in 2026. May we ever be faithful to Christ and the teachings of the Scriptures.


