Focus

God wants us to refocus our energy and refocus on the things above, Amen. Refocus means to change the emphasis or direction of things. All our life we have distractions but we have to be focus. Therefore, if you have been raised with Christ (to a new life, sharing in His resurrection from the dead), keep seeking the things that are above where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. 2 Set your mind and keep focus habitually on the things above (the heavenly things), not on things that are on the earth (which have temporary value). Colossians 3:1,2 The things we put value on as human beings is not valuable to God. God doesn't need nothing from us, He needs us to be focus on Him. If we keep our focus on Him, we will do right. 1 In those days when there was again a large crowd (gathered before him) and they had nothing to eat, Jesus called His disciple and told them 2 1 feel compassion for the crowd: they have been with Me now for three days and have nothing (left) to eat. 3 If I send them away to their homes hungry, they will faint (from exhaustion) on the road: because some have come a long way." Mark 8: 1-3 Jesus is concerned and focused on our needs. God is concerned about us, our finances, our needs, our healing and deliverance. If we keep Him as the focal point, everything will come out fine. When we take our eyes off Jesus, if you could ask Peter....when he was walking on the water and took his eyes off Jesus, he got distracted by the waves or what was going on behind him and started to sink.



A true shepherd is focused on the flock being fed. Something is wrong if you aren't sure your flock is being fed. And as preachers, we must make sure we rightly divide the word of truth and feed the flock, Amen. ⁴ His disciples replied, how are we suppose to find enough food to feed them out here in the wilderness. They (the people) are asking questions and don't know who they serve. ⁶ Jesus told all of the people to sit down on the ground. Then he took the seven loaves, thanked God for them, and broke them into pieces. He gave them to his disciples, who distributed the bread to the crowd. ⁷ a few small fish were found, too, so Jesus also blessed these and told the disciples to distribute them. ⁸ They ate as much as they wanted. Afterward, the disciples picked up seven large baskets of leftover food. Mark 8:4-8 They say when Jesus blesses something, it's more than enough. How many of you know that? Jesus is the Savior that would take His time and show us where we are wrong. If we receive the correction, He will show us. Sometimes we be so focused on our needs, physical needs, things we need and not focused on the one that fulfills our needs, the one that created us. Amen!!
