Scripture Reference: John 3:3-8

Connection:

Reflection:

Application

- In your personal journey, have you experienced the Holy Spirit in a specific or subtle way? How did that experience impact your faith and daily life?
- How does the presence of the Holy Spirit serve as a companion, helper, and advocate in the believer's life, as described in John 14:15-19?
(Reflect on practical ways the Holy Spirit provides guidance and peace in challenging situations.)
- Romans 8:15-16 describes the Holy Spirit affirming that we are God's children. How does this truth influence your identity and sense of purpose?

(Explore the transformative nature of knowing you are adopted into God's family.)

- Ryan shared how the Holy Spirit gradually transformed his life rather than through an immediate, dramatic moment. How does this perspective help you understand the process of spiritual growth in your own life?
