Question: How do you personally respond when God seems slow to act? What has long-term waiting taught you about God or about yourself?

Additional Reading: Isaiah 40:28-31

3. Faith That Costs Something

Question: What's one area of your life that God might be asking you to surrender something that would be costly, but could deepen your trust in Him?

Additional Reading: Luke 9:23-25

4. Imperfect People, Deep Faith

Question: Why do you think God chooses to work through imperfect people? How does Abraham's story encourage you when you feel like your past disqualifies you?

5. God Provides Even When We Don't See How

At the mountain, Abraham believed God would somehow provide...even raising Isaac from the dead if needed.

Question: Looking back over your life, where has God provided for you in a way you didn't expect? How does remembering past provision help you trust Him today?
