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**Sermon Title:** Bedrock: Imago Dei

**Application:**

1. Where in this sermon did you most feel challenged—or comforted—about what it means to be made in God's image? Why?
2. **Additional Bible reading: Psalm 8.** How does Psalm 8 shape your view of human dignity and our responsibility toward creation? What's one "stewardship" step you could take this week?
3. The sermon says, "Beauty isn't proof of God, but it's a signpost to Him." Where have you personally experienced beauty pointing you toward God lately, and what did it stir in you (gratitude, worship, humility, longing, etc.)?
4. **Additional Bible reading: Colossians 1:15-20.** The sermon says Jesus is the ultimate expression of God's image. According to this passage, what makes Jesus the clearest picture of God, and how does that reshape how you see yourself and others?
5. **Additional Bible reading: 2 Corinthians 5:16-21.** If we're "broken image-bearers" who can be restored in Christ, what does this passage

say has changed about us—and what's one relationship, habit, or desire where you need that restoration to show up right now?
