Convention Registration FAQs

- When will I be able to register for Convention?
 Convention registration will open on February 26 and will remain open through March 26.
- I don't plan to attend Diocesan Convention, but I would like to go to the Eucharist and reception at St. James in Alexandria the night before. Do I need to register? Yes, you should register as a Visitor. We need a head count to determine how much food to order for the reception.
- I was elected a Convention Alternate at my church's annual meeting but am not needed to replace any of our delegates. However, I'd still like to attend Convention. Do I need to register?
 - Yes. Make sure you register as a Visitor, not a Delegate, since you will not be serving as a Delegate.
- I am not a Delegate or clergyperson but am coming to Diocesan Convention to display a ministry that I lead at my church. Do I need to register?
 Yes, you should register as a Vendor.
- I will be attending Convention as a Delegate from my church and have also been asked to set up a display table to showcase a diocesan commission I'm on. Do I register as a Delegate or a Vendor?
 You should register as a Delegate and also indicate on the registration form that you need a display table.
- The rector at my church certified me as a delegate back in January. Do I still need to register for Convention?
 - Yes. Delegate Certification is not the same thing as Convention registration. Everyone who is attending Convention must register so that we will know how many tables to set up, how much food to order, etc.
