On Campus Volunteer Opportunities

- Bus Buddy (first 2 days of school only)/Ride the bus home with students to assist driver.
- Pre-K, Kinder, 1st Grade Classroom Helper (first day of school only)/Short training required-Assist teachers with getting students to their classes, lunch, and with classroom activities.
- **❖ Backpack Buddy** (Fridays)/Stuff backpacks with donated food.
- Library Helper/Shelve books in the library; Book Fairs
- **Workroom Helper**/Assist in workroom with laminating, cutting, stapling.
- Help sort snacks for holiday parties. (2 parties during the year)
- Mentor (30 minutes a week)/District training required—Play games, complete puzzles, make a craft, read a book, help with homework, whatever you would like to do to make a difference.
- * After School Club Helper (varies)/Assist with after school clubs.
- Field Day Helper (May)/Face painting, game stations, setting up tents, etc.

Off Campus Volunteer Opportunities

- **Staff Appreciation Gifts**/Create and package/prepare gifts for staff members
- Snacks-Meals/Help provide, cook, and/or serve snacks and meals for staff members for staff appreciation (several times per year).
- Purchase snacks and small games and/or toys for prizes to give away to students at academic camps.
- Backpack Buddy (Wednesdays)/Pick up donated food from food bank and deliver to Hairgrove.
- Clothes Drive/Donations, sorting, delivery, and set-up.
- Holiday Food Give-Away/Collect and distribute meals for Thanksgiving and Christmas-pray with families.
- Christmas Gifts/Select a name/s to purchase and wrap gifts for (\$25 limit per person selected)--Gifts are in combination with families receiving Christmas Holiday Food Give-Away.
- Monetary Donations/Money may be donated for needs for Hairgrove students and their families, staff appreciation, and general Hairgrove needs.
