# Young Couples: SS 211


A short lesson followed by group discussion. Currently studying the Westminster Standards, the Confession of Faith, and the Larger and Shorter Catechisms.

- A theology of Holy Saturday is of crucial importance for many things, especially sustained, faithful, and fervent prayer...
- It was a day of anguished disappointment, regret, and failure. All their hopes were ruthlessly dashed upon the rocks of the previous day.
- It was a day when it seemed that death had the last word.
  - For the One claiming to be the Son of the God of life
  - was buried and defeated by death.
  - The disciples were isolated, alone, and hiding away in fear for their lives.
- It was a day of silence from God.
  - In all this distress and darkness and uncertainty,
