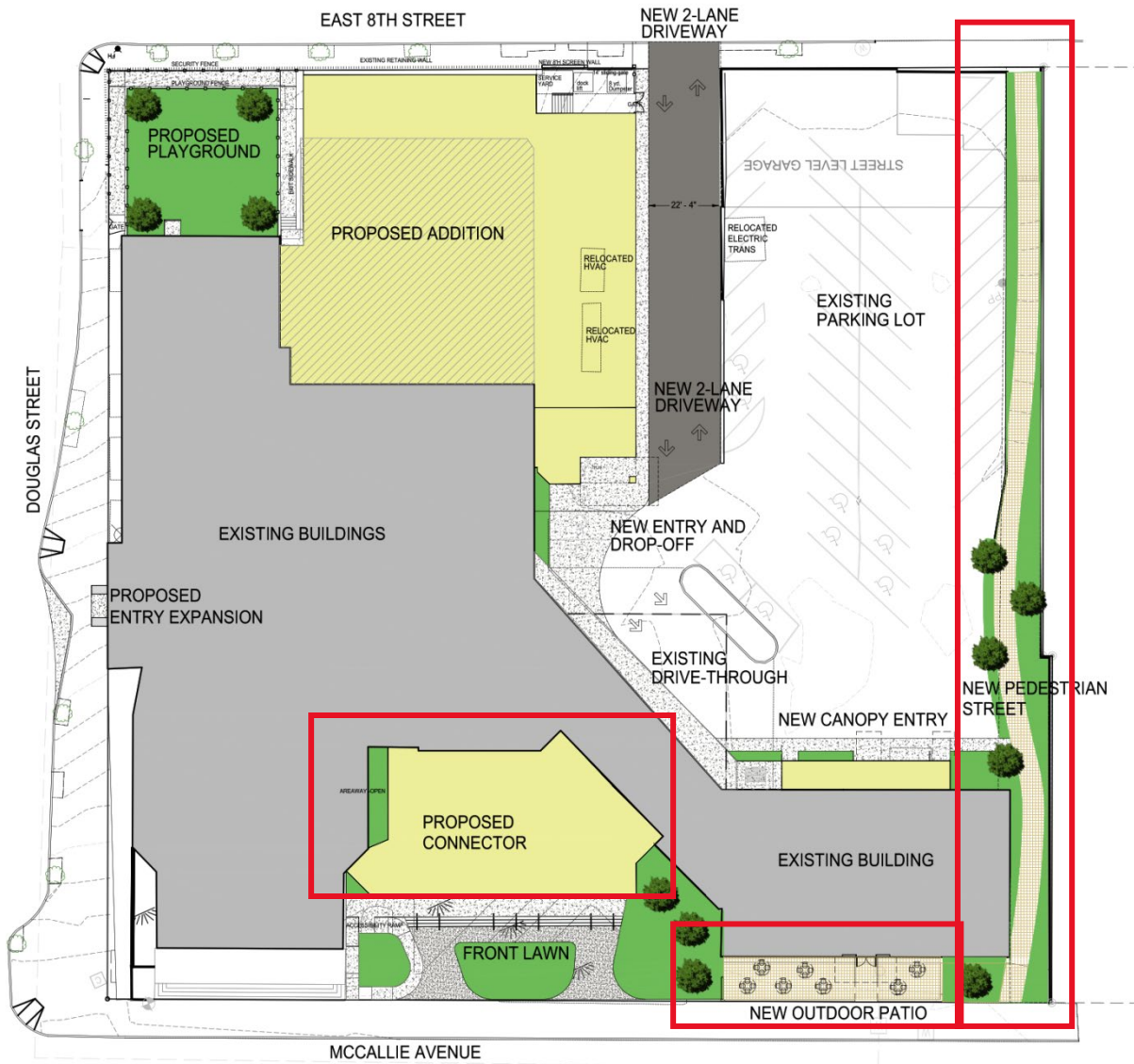

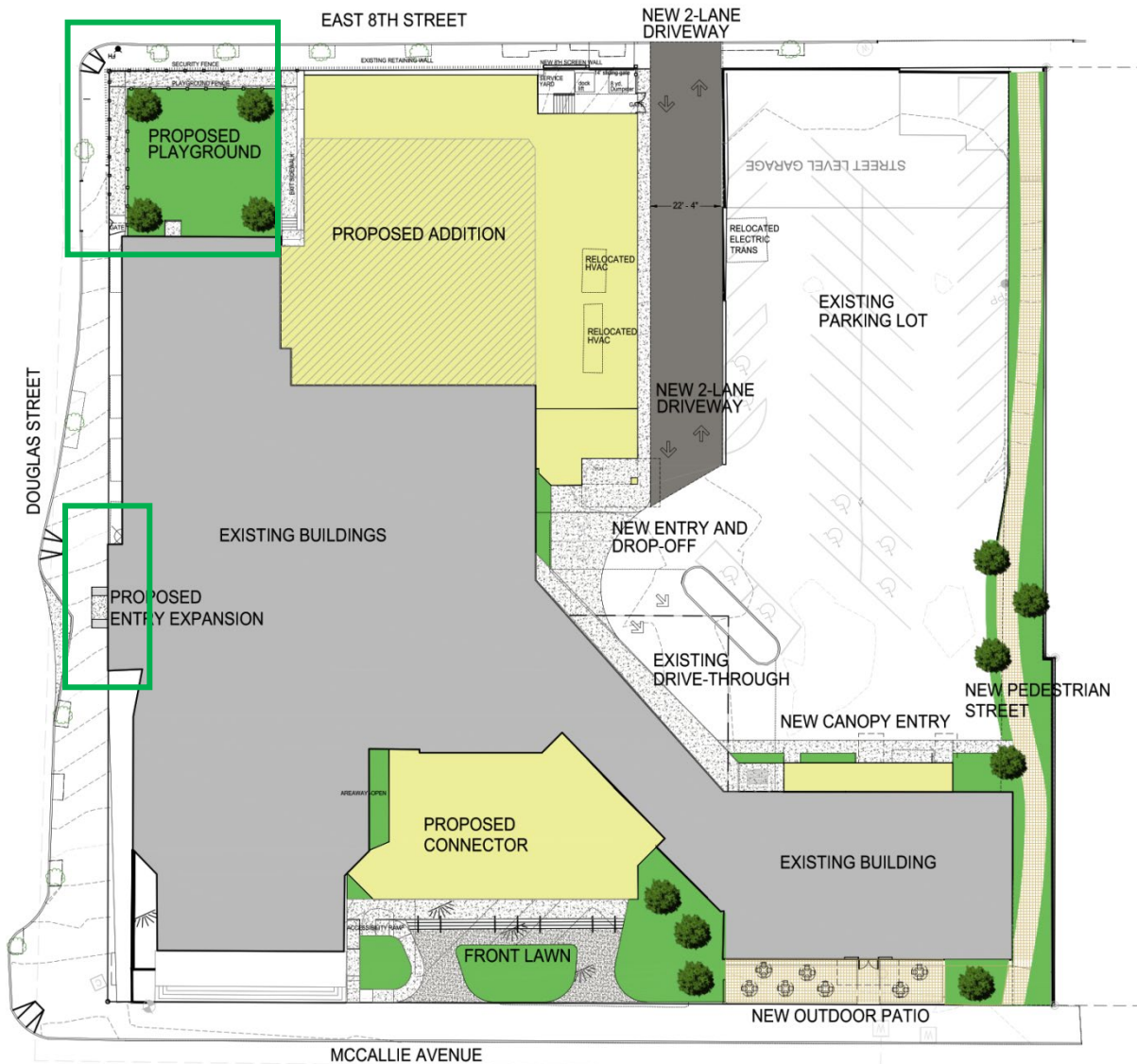







 Existing Fellowship Hall to be demolished

- McCallie Ave**
- New connector with covered porch provides accessibility to all buildings
 - Modified front lawn
 - Outdoor patio and covered entry in front of proposed cafe
 - Pedestrian street replaces narrow drive



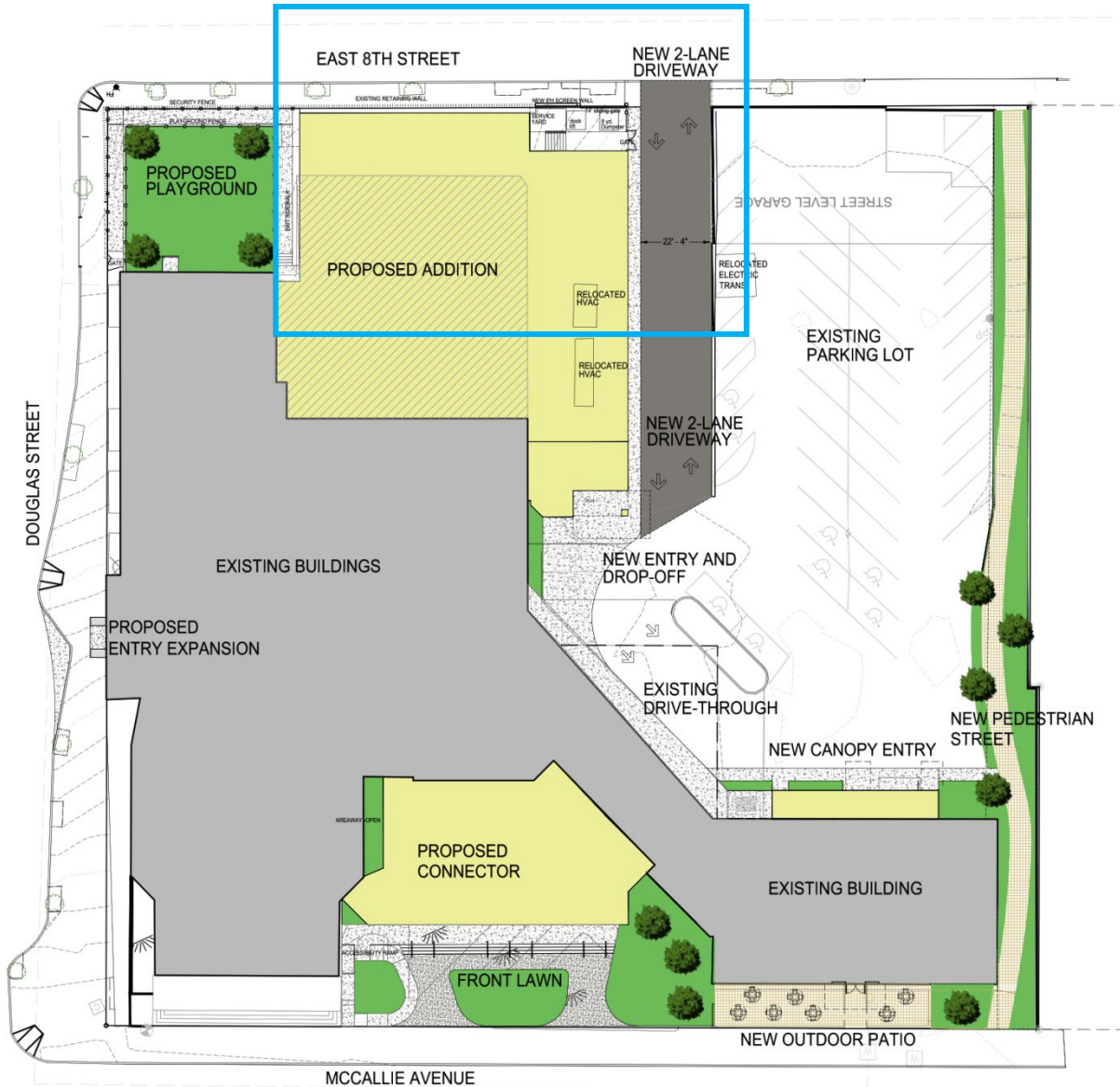
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Douglas St

- Double lane parking entrance and exit



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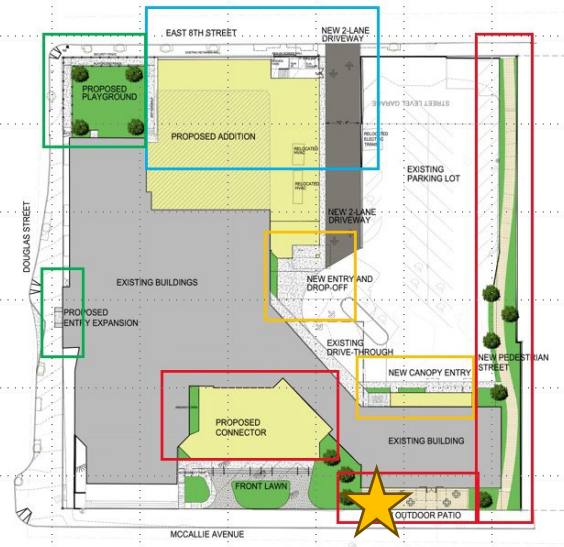
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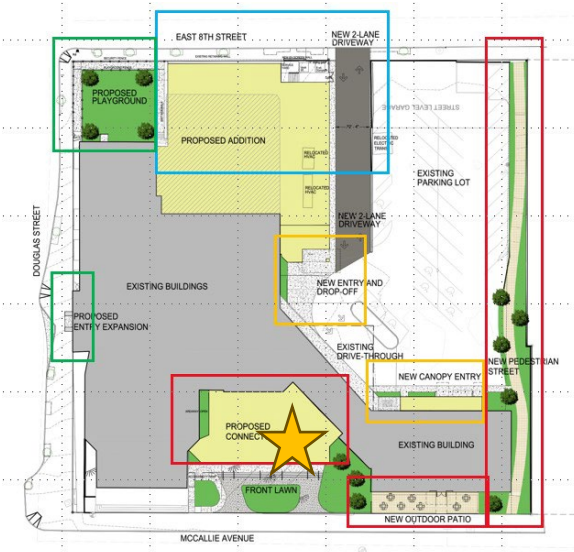
Rear Parking Plaza

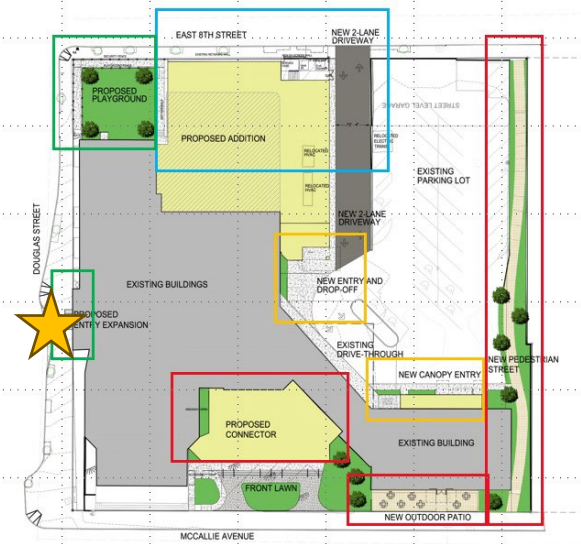


McCallie Ave

NEW CONNECTOR

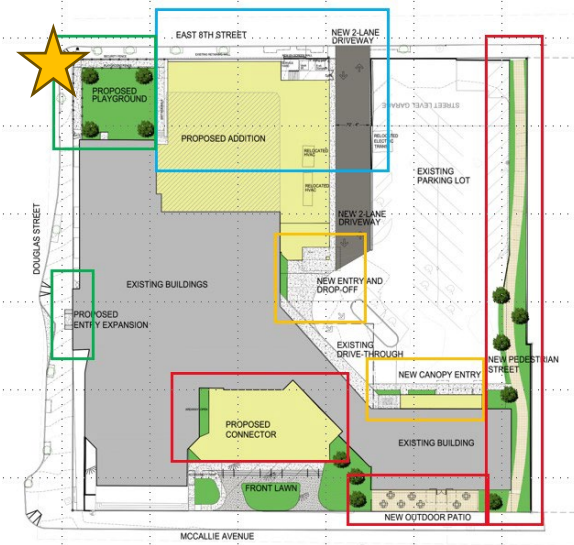


Douglas St

- Designed as a key building entrance for those parking in the Douglas Street parking lot



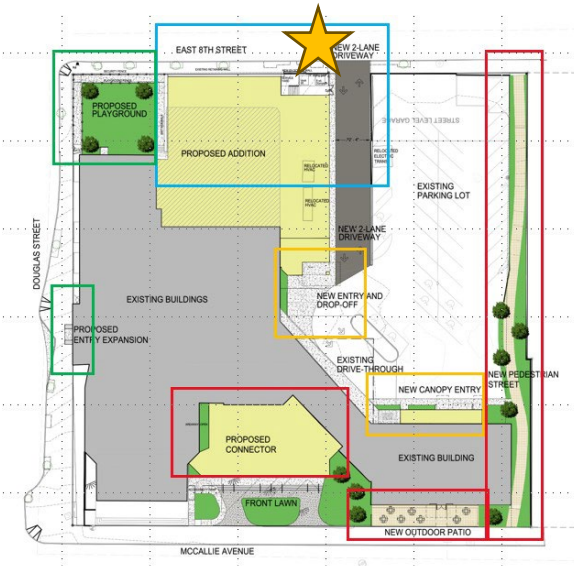

- Playground also accessible from fellowship hall level



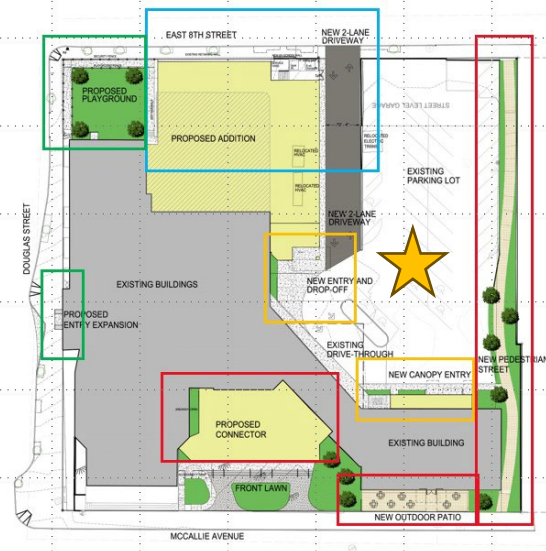


East 8th St

- Double lane rear parking entrance and exit

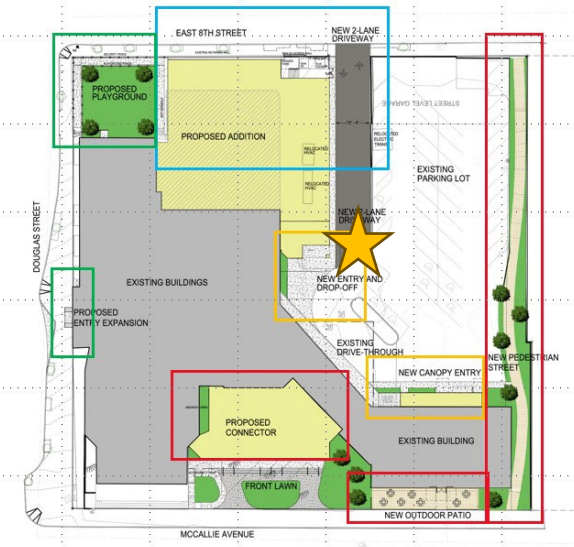


NEW FELLOWSHIP HALL WITH 2-WAY DRIVE

- Visible building signage

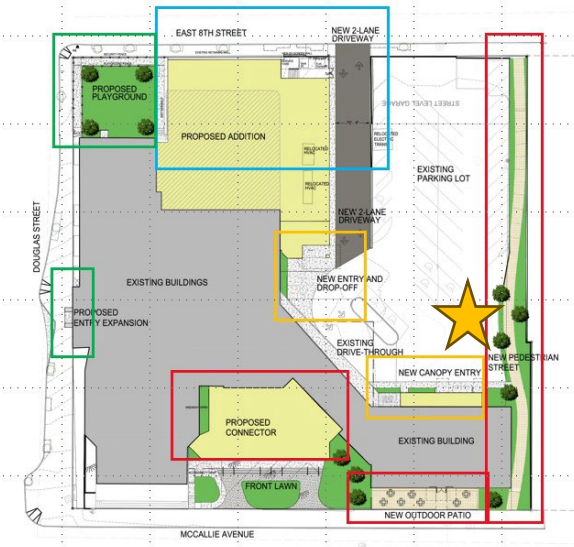


Rear Parking Plaza

 - Bike racks for new pedestrian alley



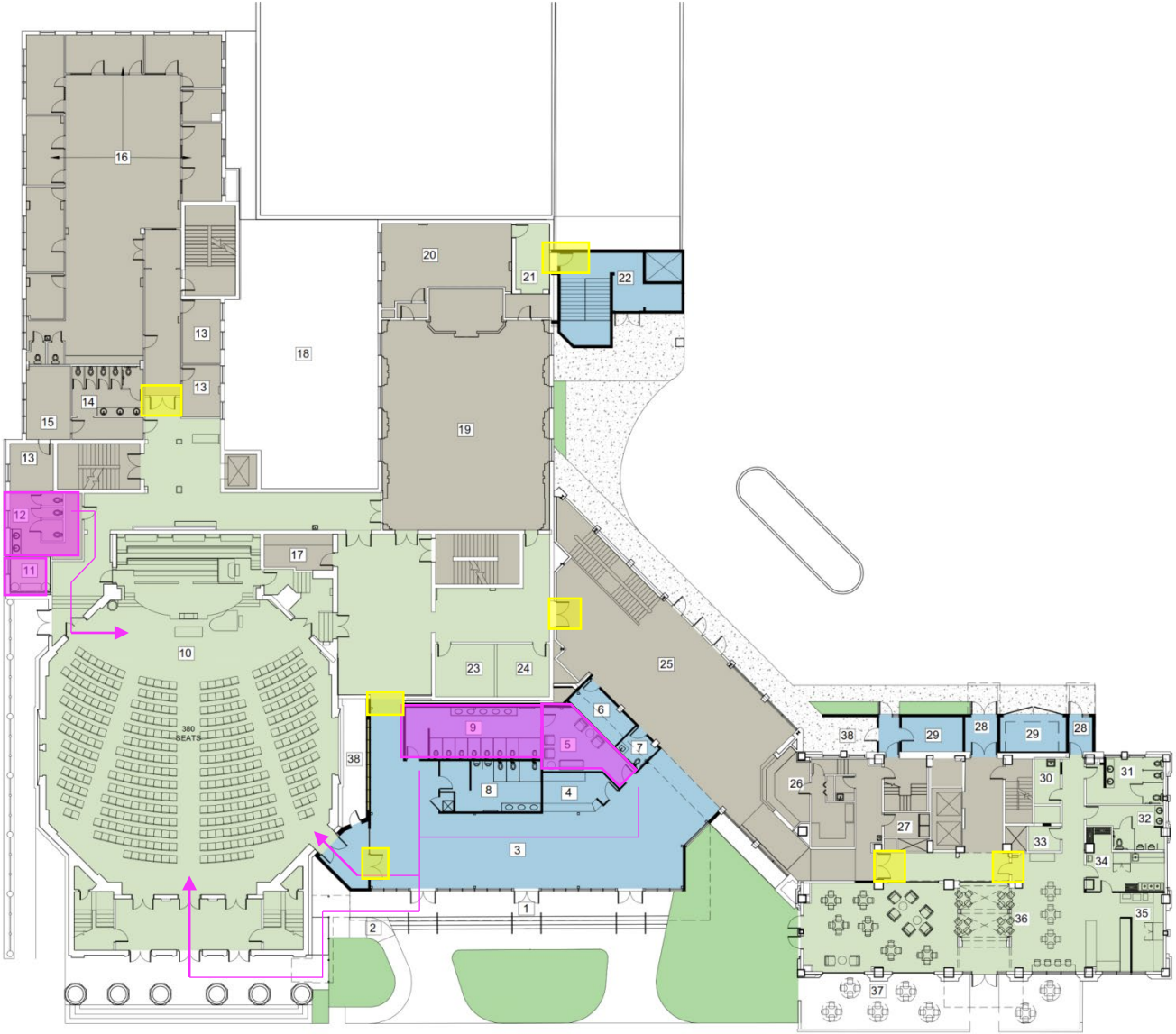

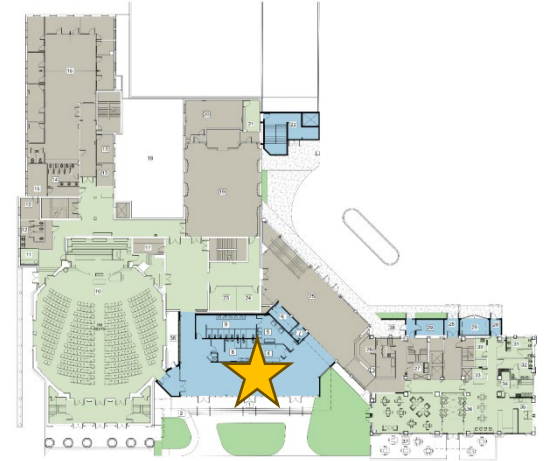
MAIN LEVEL SCHEMATIC PLANS FOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS



Soundproofing to be installed in vestibule to sanctuary

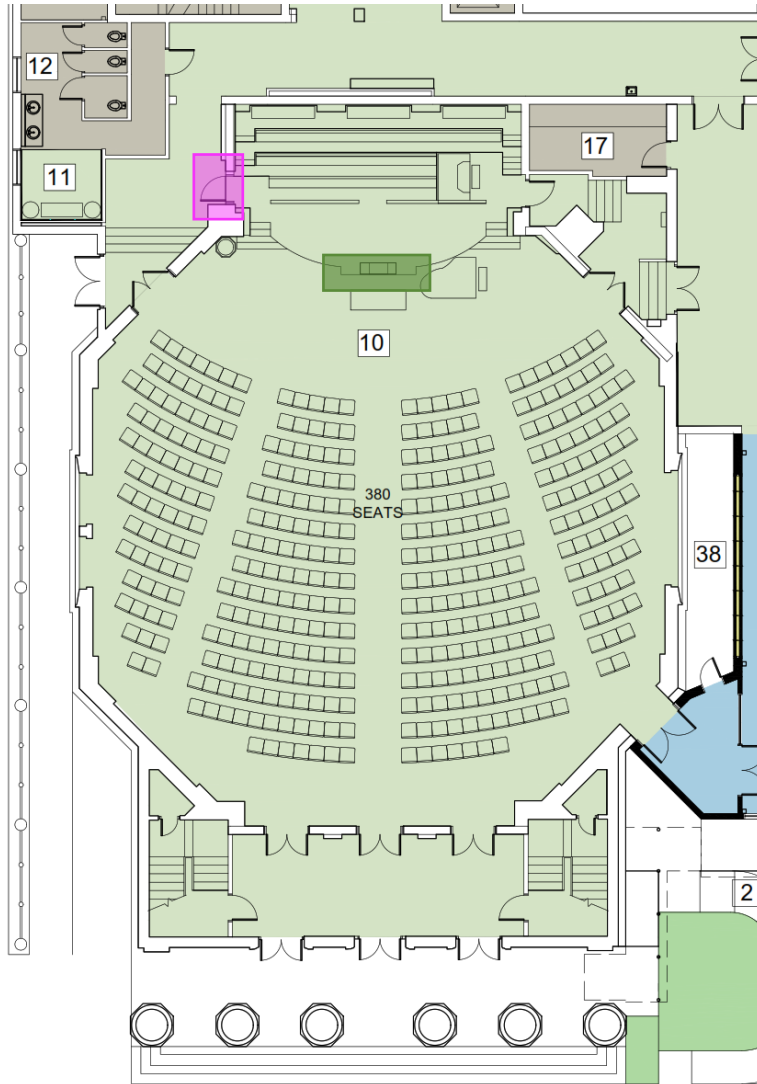
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21. VESTIBULE	

NOTE: Glazing at Areaway (38) can be opened to access stained glass for maintenance



- Provides accessible connection to the existing connector hallway and current lobbies
- Large commons area with accessible restrooms
- Women's lounge can also be used as a bridal room
- Coffee and refreshment station next to a greeter station for visitors

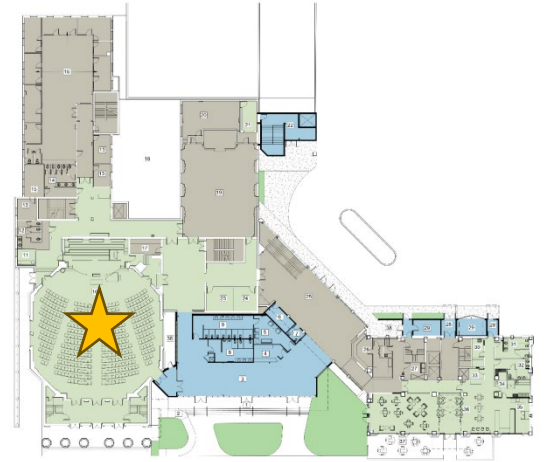
NEW CONNECTOR PROPOSED INTERIOR CONCEPT

 New entrance for choir and weddings

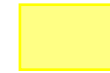
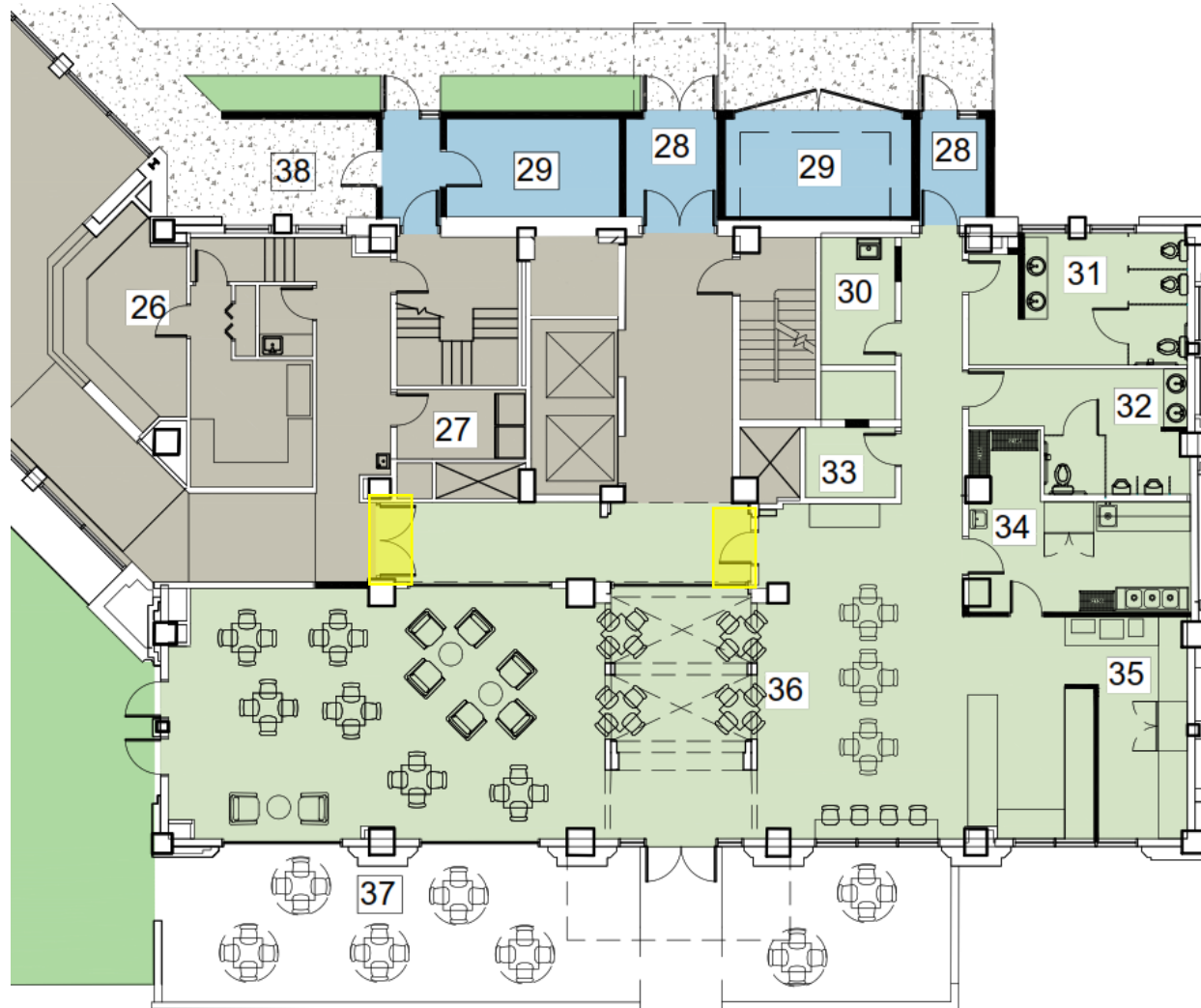
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MODIFICATIONS TO EXISTING SANCTUARY






- New floor finishes, replace existing acoustical wall treatment with new, and paint existing walls and trim
- Enlarged projection screens
- New seating to complement historical context
- Upgrades to lighting and HVAC as needed
- Replace HVAC grilles with historically appropriate models

SANCTUARY PROPOSED INTERIOR CONCEPT

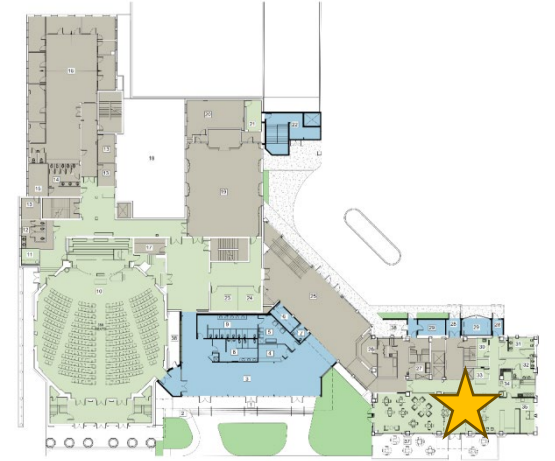

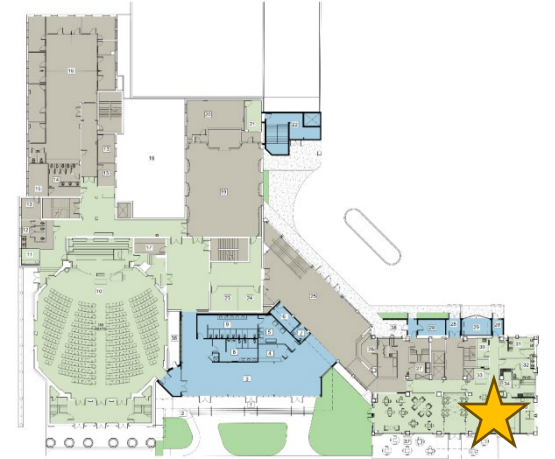
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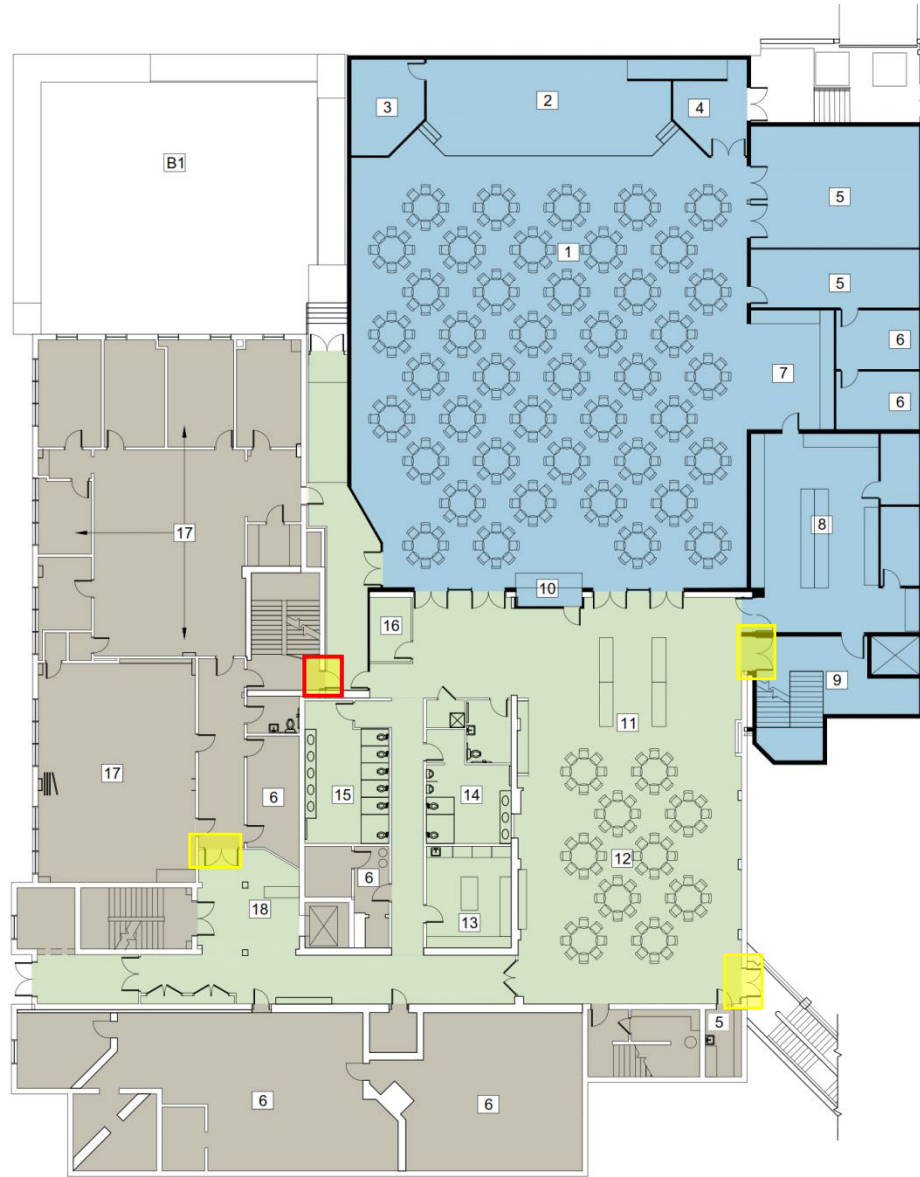
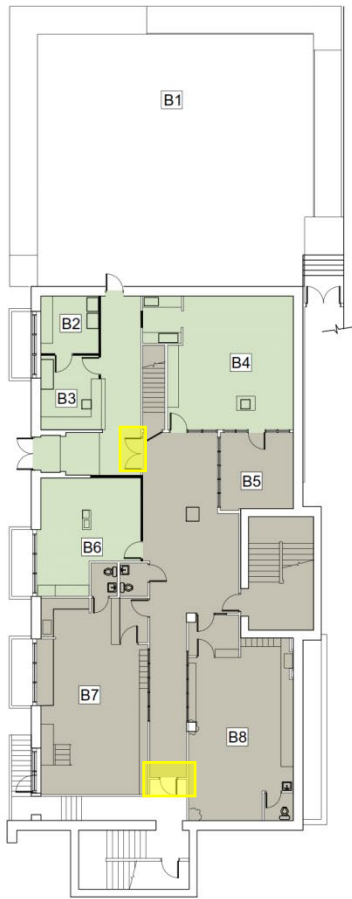
FIRST FLOOR TOWER PROPOSED CAFÉ LAYOUT

- Modify ceilings and finishes in a manner that maintains original architectural character



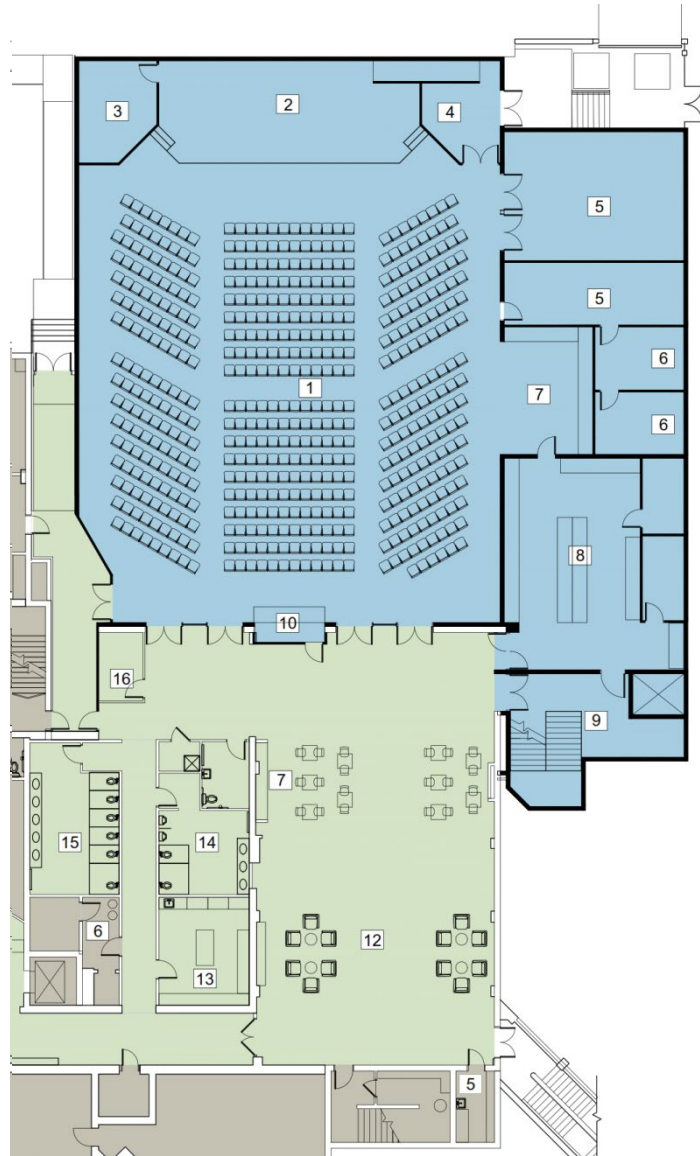
- Varied seating types

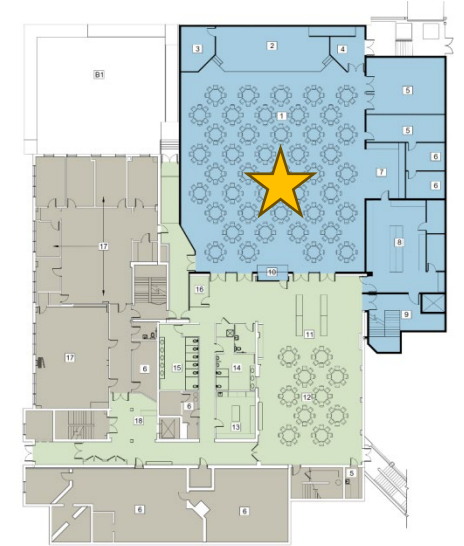
