## **Active Exploratory Learning**

Experiential learning has the advantage of using a number of different learning styles to teach concepts. Some things just need to be memorized to lay a foundation for more critical thinking. Other concepts are easier to remember when we get to experience them. Our students experience both as they build projects, explore science, and live out their faith in service. The kindergarten class is a good example of this type of learning. In the pictures below you will see that C is for camping. Students sit around a campfire to read and develop social skills. E is for experiment as they marvel at how Mementos react to soda. Seventh grade students use new probes to test their tanks and drinking water for ammonia, nitrates, and oxygen levels. They can immediately determine runoff from the fields. The second grade studies kinetic energy using Lego robotics to build a miniputt course. Learning is active, not passive at Immanuel.
