Intentionality towards the nations

Some ideas to increase our awareness and rhythm to pray:

- Pray for WoodsEdge Missionaries (Colossians 4:3-4)
- Pray for nations listed in the news. (*Psalms 22:27-28*)
- Prayer for an increase in workers for the harvest to share the Gospel throughout the world. (*Matthew 9:37-38, Luke 10:2, 2 Thessalonians 3:1*)
- Pray for provision for food and water in the countries that struggle to provide. (*Psalms 146:6-7, Matthew 25: 31-40*)

PRAYER WARRIORS:

Please pray that we would gain a heart ignited for missions. As we are reminded of the many verses emphasizing God’s love for all people, spend time in praying for a personal and collective deeper understanding of God’s heart for the nations.

Prayer Points

1. Please pray for God’s power to move throughout all the earth.
 - a. **Genesis 12:3**- *“I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”*
 - b. **Acts 1:8**- *“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”*
 - c. **2 Chronicles 16:9**- *“For the eyes of the Lord run to and from throughout the whole earth, to give strong support to those whose heart is blameless toward him...”*
 - d. **Exodus 9:16**- *“But for this purpose I have raised you up, to show you my power, so that my name may be proclaimed in all the earth.”*
2. Please pray for God to be known and praised in every nation.
 - a. **1 Samuel 17:46**- *“...that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel, and that all this assembly may know the Lord saves not with sword and spear. For the battle is the Lord’s...”*
 - b. **Joshua 4:24**- *“...so that all the peoples of the earth may know that the hand of the Lord is mighty, that you may fear the Lord your God forever.”*
 - c. **1 King 8:59-60**- *“Let these words of mine, with which I have pleaded before the Lord, be near to the Lord our God day and night, and may he maintain the cause of his servant and the cause of his people Israel, as each day requires, that all the peoples of the earth may know that the Lord is God; there is no other.”*

- Pray through the continents. (1 Timothy 2: 1-2, Psalm 67:1-5, Psalm 22:28)
- Pray for the hearts of government leaders around the world. (Proverbs 21:1, Psalm 2: 10-11, Proverbs 11:14, Philippians 2: 3)

3. Please pray for all of the lost across the world to find Jesus as Savior.
 - a. **Matthew 15:24-** *“He answered, “I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.”*
 - b. **1 Timothy 2:3-4-** *“This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.”*
 - c. **Romans 10: 12-13-** *“For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches on all who call on him. For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.””*

Upcoming Events

Pray over these upcoming events in your weekly intercession time.

Easter Services | Saturday, April 4th & Sunday, April 5th

The Resurrection of Jesus changes everything. These are services of celebration, invitation, and gospel proclamation. Pray that the truth of the Resurrection is received with fresh wonder and power. Ask for softened hearts, divine encounters, and breakthroughs in salvation. Lift up each team on campus- facilities, tech, worship, childcare, and the many volunteers who help create space for people to meet Jesus.

WE Join Classes (English and Español) | April 19th

Ask God to reveal their next steps in faith. Lift up leaders to welcome and guide both our English and Español participants in wisdom. Pray that this event strengthens connections and inspires long-term commitment to community.

Adult Baptism Class | April 26th

This class is designed to prepare adults for the step of baptism- rooted in personal faith and obedience to Jesus. Pray for each participant to experience confidence and joy as they prepare to publicly declare their faith. Ask that this season becomes a spiritual milestone that leads to deeper intimacy, with Christ and lifelong discipleship.
