Celebrate the Gift of Freedom

Prayer Points

- Supremacy of Christ in Our Lives** Pray that Christ remains the central focus of our lives, acknowledging His preeminence in all we do. (Col 1:15-18; Phil 2:9-11)
- Anchored in His Refuge** Thank God for being our ever-present refuge and strength in times of trouble. Pray for His peace to reign in our hearts amid life's storms. (Ps 46:1-3; Isa 41:10)
- Faithful in Suffering** Ask for steadfastness in trials, remembering that suffering for Christ is a privilege that shapes us into His likeness. (Col 1:24; 2 Cor 4:17)
- Unity in the Body of Christ** Pray for unity within the church, seeking to bear one another's burdens and reflect Christ's love to a divided world. (1 Cor 1:10; Eph 4:2-3)
- Strength to Hold the Torch High** Pray for courage to live out and proclaim the gospel boldly, as Paul urged the Colossians. (Col 1:28-29; Mt 5:16)
- Hope in the Midst of Chaos** Lift up those facing personal and communal challenges, asking God to be their anchor and restore hope in His unfailing promises. (Ps 46:10-11; Rom 15:13)
- Christ as Our Peace** Pray for reconciliation and peace in strained relationships, asking God to reconcile all things to Himself through Christ. (Col 1:20; 2 Cor 5:18-19)
- God's Strength in Our Weakness** Ask God to empower us with His Spirit to overcome anxiety, fear, and spiritual weariness, trusting in His sovereign strength. (2 Cor 12:9; Ps 34:17-18)
- Bearing His Image** Pray that we would live as true image-bearers, reflecting His grace, truth, and love to a watching world. (Genesis 1:27; 2 Corinthians 3:18)
- Be Still and Know** Take moments of stillness to reflect on God's presence, surrendering every concern and trusting in His supreme authority. (Psalm 46:10; Exodus 14:14)

Walk in the Light of His Truth

"The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world." – John 1:9

Pray for clarity and guidance as God's light shines in our lives, illuminating paths of righteousness and driving out darkness.

Reflect His Glory

Pray that we would reflect the glory of Christ in our words, actions, and relationships, becoming living testimonies of His grace and truth.

Rest in His Peace

Pray for hearts that rest in the peace of Christ, the Lamb of God, as we celebrate His humble arrival and eternal reign.

Upcoming Events

Pray over these upcoming events in your weekly intercession time.

Student Ministry Christmas Party | December 11

Pray for a joyful and Christ-centered celebration where students feel a deep sense of belonging and connection. Ask for meaningful conversations that foster spiritual growth and friendships that reflect God's love. Pray for the leaders as they guide the event, that they would have wisdom and energy to engage each student with care and intentionality.

Men on Mission Breakfast | December 14

Pray for men to be inspired and equipped to step boldly into God's mission for their lives. Ask that the conversations over breakfast lead to strengthened relationships and renewed commitments to serving their families and communities. Pray for clarity and vision as they discuss opportunities to make an impact for the Kingdom.

JOYBridge Respite Afternoon | December 15

Pray for peace and joy to fill the hearts of families participating, particularly for children with special needs. Ask for energy, compassion, and wisdom for the volunteers, that they would create a safe and loving environment. Pray that this time of respite would provide much-needed refreshment for parents and caregivers, and that it strengthens their sense of community and support.

Young Adults Christmas Party | December 19

Pray for a vibrant and Christ-focused gathering that encourages young adults to grow deeper in their faith and in fellowship with one another. Ask for new attendees to feel welcome and valued, finding a place where they can belong and thrive. Pray that the time together fosters both spiritual growth and lasting friendships, contributing to a strong and unified church community.
