December is here with the opportunity to pause and reflect. We wait in anticipation for Jesus' arrival, God's faithfulness in keeping his promises to redeem from brokenness. Pause and press in for each day, both in the waiting and in the celebrating within the hope, peace, joy and love of our God. We Merry Christmas and praise to our King Jesus.

Week 1 of Advent- Hope- We remember the prophecies of Jesus' arrival and reflect on God's promises.

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. Colossians 1:15

I will put hostility between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring. He will strike your head, and you will strike his heel. Genesis 3:15

I will bless those who bless you, I will curse anyone who treats you with contempt, and all the peoples on earth will be blessed through you. Genesis 12:3

Week 2 of Advent- Peace- We center our hearts in preparation for Jesus's arrival and the peace he brings.

Rejoice greatly, daughter Zion! Shout in triumph, daughter Jerusalem! Look, your king is coming to you; he is righteous and victorious, humble and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey. Zechariah 9:9

Atonement will be made for you on this day to cleanse you, and you will be clean from all your sins before the Lord. Leviticus 16:30

Week 3 of Advent- Joy- We rejoice at the arrival of God's kingdom through Jesus.
