"And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross." - Colossians 2:13-14

Living in Christ's Forgiveness and Victory

Receiving Christ's Complete Forgiveness

"As far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us." - Psalm 103:12

Pray that we fully embrace Christ's forgiveness, rejecting guilt and shame. May we walk in the confidence that our sins are completely removed by His grace.

Extending Grace to Others

"Bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive." - Colossians 3:13

Pray that we reflect Christ's love by forgiving others, letting go of bitterness, and pursuing reconciliation.

PRAYER WARRIORS:

This month, we turn our focus to the life-giving power of Christ's redemption. Once dead in sin, we are now alive in Him—fully forgiven, restored, and victorious. The cross was not just an act of love but a declaration of freedom. Our sins, once an insurmountable debt, have been completely canceled by His sacrifice. As we pray together in February, let us fully embrace this truth. May we walk in confidence, grace, and victory, refusing to be held captive by shame or fear. May we extend Christ's forgiveness to others and live boldly in the newness of life He has given us. Let's seek Him together, standing firm in the power of the cross!

Prayer Points

1. **Gratitude for Christ's Redemption** Pray with gratitude for Christ's redeeming love, thanking Him for the complete forgiveness of our sins. Ask for a renewed appreciation of His sacrifice. (Ephesians 1:7)
2. **Walking in New Life** Pray that we live each day fully aware of our identity in Christ, rejecting sin and embracing the abundant life He offers. (Romans 6:11)
3. **Breaking Free from Guilt and Shame** Ask God to remove any lingering guilt or shame, replacing it with peace and joy in His grace. (Romans 8:1)
4. **Freedom from the Lies of the Enemy** Pray for discernment to reject the enemy's accusations and stand firm in the truth of God's Word. (John 8:32)
5. **Strength to Forgive Others** Ask God to soften our hearts, helping us forgive those who have wronged us just as He has forgiven us. (Matthew 6:12)
6. **Boldness in Sharing the Gospel** Pray for courage to share Christ's redemption with others, that many would come to know His saving grace. (Matthew 28:19)
7. **Revival in Our Church and Community** Pray for revival- hearts turning back to God, spiritual renewal, and a hunger for His presence in our church and beyond. (2 Chronicles 7:14)

Confidence in Christ's Redemption

"There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus." – Romans 8:1
Pray for freedom from the enemy's accusations and for a renewed boldness in our identity as redeemed children of God.

Made New by His Spirit

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." – 2 Corinthians 5:17
Pray for a deeper awareness of our new life in Christ, leaving behind the weight of past failures and wading in renewal.

Resisting the Enemy's Lies

"Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." – James 4:7
Pray for discernment to recognize the lies of the enemy and the strength to stand firm in God's truth.

Prayer Points (continued)

- 8. Walking in Spiritual Authority** Pray for believers to walk boldly in the victory of Christ, resisting fear and trusting in His power. (Luke 10:19)
- 9. Strength for Those Facing Trials** Lift up those in our community who are struggling with hardship, illness, or loss, asking for God's strength, comfort, and provision. (2 Corinthians 12:9)
- 10. A Heart of Worship and Thanksgiving** Pray that our church would be marked by joyful worship, thanking God for His goodness in every season. (Psalm 100:4)

PRAY for: Upcoming Events

Pray over these upcoming events in your weekly intercession time.

iChoose Retreat | February 7-9

Pray that children encounter God's love and grow in wisdom. Ask for the Holy Spirit's presence in worship and teaching. Lift up leaders and volunteers for strength and joy as they serve. Pray that each child leaves with a deeper understanding of their identity in Christ. (James 1:5; Proverbs 3:5-6; Galatians 6:9)

WE Join | February 9

Ask God to reveal their next steps in faith. Lift up leaders to welcome and guide them with wisdom. Pray that this event strengthens connections and inspires long-term commitment to community. (Romans 15:7; Hebrews 10:24-25; 1 Peter 4:10-11)

KidsEdge Preschool New Family Registration | February 10

Pray for families seeking Christ-centered education. Ask for wisdom and patience for teachers. Lift up preschoolers to grow in faith and knowledge. Pray that God provides peace and confidence to parents making this important decision. (Proverbs 22:6; Isaiah 54:13; Matthew 18:5)

Group Formation | February 16

Pray for meaningful connections in new groups. Ask for wisdom for leaders as they disciple. Lift up the church body to grow in unity and faith. Pray that each group becomes a place of encouragement, accountability, and spiritual growth. (Acts 2:42-47; Ecclesiastes 4:9-10; Galatians 6:2)
