Abiding in the Presence of Christ

See His Grace Overflowing

"From his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace." - John 1:16
Pray for an awareness of His overflowing grace in every moment of life.

Behold the Light of the World

"The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." - John 1:5
Thank God for being our light, overcoming every shadow in our lives.

Live as His Children

"To all who did receive him... he gave the right to become children of God." - John 1:12
Celebrate the privilege of being God's children, living as heirs of His kingdom.

PRAYER WARRIORS:

As we enter a new year, we reflect on the awe-inspiring glory of Christ, who became flesh and dwelt among us. His incarnation marks the ultimate revelation of God's love and grace. In every season of life, we have hope in His unchanging nature and the eternal promise of His presence. This month, let us center our prayers on the life-transforming truth of Christ's glory, His grace, and His truth.

Prayer Points

1. **Beholding His Glory** Pray that our eyes remain fixed on Christ, marveling at His glory revealed in the gospel. (John 1:14; Exodus 33:18)
2. **Living in Grace and Truth** Ask God to help us walk in the balance of grace and truth, reflecting Christ in our relationships and decisions. (John 1:17; Ephesians 4:15)
3. **Anchored in Hope** Pray that in trials, we anchor our souls in the hope of Christ's return and His ultimate victory. (John 16:33; Romans 5:1-5)
4. **Strength for the Journey** Seek God's strength as we live faithfully for Him, drawing from His fullness and grace upon grace. (John 1:16; Isaiah 40:29-31)
5. **Community in Christ** Lift up the church body, asking for deep connections that foster mutual encouragement and accountability. (Hebrews 10:24-25; 2 Timothy 4:9-13)
6. **Boldness in Proclamation** Pray for courage to proclaim the gospel boldly, like the Apostle Paul, no matter the cost. (2 Timothy 4:17; Matthew 28:18-20)
7. **Celebrating the Incarnation** Thank God for the wonder of the incarnation, meditating on His humility and love. (Philippians 2:5-8; John 1:1-3)
8. **God's Presence in Our Lives** Rejoice that God dwells within us, transforming us into His likeness through His Spirit. (1 Corinthians 3:16; 2 Corinthians 3:18)
9. **Pursuing His Glory** Pray that we would continually seek God's glory, asking Him to reveal His character and majesty to us daily. (Psalm 27:4; John 17:24)
10. **Urgency in Our Call** Pray for a heart that acts now, living fully for Christ without delay. (2 Timothy 4:2; Ephesians 5:15-16)

re:generation Recovery | Mondays Continuing January 6

Pray for participants to experience God's transformative power as they seek healing and freedom from personal struggles. Ask for openness and vulnerability within the group, fostering a safe environment for growth and support. Pray for the leaders to be filled with wisdom, compassion, and discernment as they guide individuals toward lasting recovery in Christ.

re|engage | Thursdays Starting January 16

Pray for couples to experience renewed intimacy, understanding, and commitment in their marriages. Ask for open hearts and honest communication as they engage with the program. Pray for the facilitators to lead with grace and wisdom, creating an atmosphere where couples can thrive and strengthen their relationships under God's guidance.

Freedom Weekend | January 25-26

Pray for students to encounter the life-changing power of Christ, breaking free from anything that holds them back. Ask for deep, personal encounters with God through worship, teaching, and small groups. Pray that this weekend inspires lasting transformation and equips students to walk in freedom and boldness.

Word and Spirit Class | Starting January 26

Pray for a powerful and balanced understanding of God's Word and the Holy Spirit's work, equipping participants to live Spirit-filled lives grounded in biblical truth. Ask that each attendee experiences a deeper relationship with God, gaining clarity and confidence in using their spiritual gifts for His glory. Pray for the facilitators to teach with wisdom and discernment, creating an environment where faith and empowerment thrive. May the class foster unity, encourage boldness in faith, and ignite a passion for both Word and Spirit in every participant.

Women's Bible Study | Starting January 27

Pray for rich discussions and spiritual growth as participants explore Scripture together. Ask for strong connections to form among the women, creating a supportive and encouraging community. Lift up the missions outreach and potluck in the final week, that it would inspire greater service and fellowship.

Women's Night of Worship | January 31

Pray for a powerful and Spirit-filled evening of worship, where women encounter God's presence in a profound way. Ask for hearts to be uplifted and renewed through worship and fellowship. Pray for new connections to be made, encouraging participants to grow in their faith and unity with one another.
