Position Summary

The Maintenance Tech at WoodsEdge plays an essential role in supporting the maintenance, operations, and overall safety of the church's facilities. Responsibilities include assisting with facility upgrades, renovations, routine maintenance, and troubleshooting, as well as contributing to various improvement and construction projects.
