### His Power in Our Weakness

## PRAYER WARRIORS:

As we are days into the Awaken Houston city-wide fast, pray that the hunger for more intentional time with the Father would spread. Pray that we would each individually experience the fullness of sustenance found only in Christ Jesus.

### Prayer Points

1. Please pray that we would choose the "good portion" of presence and contentment with Jesus, as he stated in Luke 10: 42. Within this, that we would each choose:
  - a. **Being with Jesus over Doing for Jesus.**
  - b. **Worshipping God over Working for God.**
2. Please pray that the body of Christ would experience Jesus as Nourisher. He is:
  - a. **The Bread of life.** *John 6:35*
  - b. **Living Water.** *John 4:14*
  - c. **The True Vine.** *John 15: 1,4*
  - d. **The Bread and Wine of Communion.** *Luke 22:19-20*
3. Please pray for hearts to burn for prayer and to become lovers of Jesus. Please pray for:
  - a. **Heartfelt Desire.** *Romans 10:1, Psalm 27:8*
  - b. **Sincere Seeking.** *Jeremiah 29:13, John 15:7*
  - c. **Relentless Persistence.** *Luke 18:1, Matthew 21:22, Ephesians 6:18, Colossians 1:9, Colossians 4:12-13*
  - d. **Deep hearted Devotion.** *Matthew 22:37-38, Ephesians 6:24, Matthew 6:33, Matthew 16:24.*
