Prayer Points

- Pray for a steadfast spirit that draws you into regular, heartfelt prayer, even when life feels busy or overwhelming. (Romans 12:12; 1 Thessalonians 5:17)
- Ask God to ignite a passion for prayer within our church, uniting us as a community committed to praying without ceasing for one another and the world. (1 Timothy 2:1; Acts 1:14)
- Pray for unity in the body of Christ, asking God to knit us together in genuine love and understanding as we seek Him. (1 Corinthians 1:10; Ephesians 4:3)
- Invite God to shape your heart for others, growing in you a willingness to serve, forgive, and support those around you as part of His family. (Galatians 6:2; Ephesians 4:32)
- Pray that our church would be a place where deep, life-giving relationships flourish, allowing us to grow together in faith and encourage each other in both trials and victories. (Hebrews 10:24-25; 1 Thessalonians 5:11)
- Pray for a heart that seeks God's glory above personal comfort, asking Him to give you the strength and courage to follow wherever He leads. (Matthew 16:24; Luke 22:42)
- Ask God to reveal areas in your life where He may be calling you to sacrifice or serve others more deeply, embracing His purpose with joy. (Hebrews 13:16; Ephesians 2:10)
- Pray for our church to be a light, ready to serve, love, and give generously as we live out His kingdom values here on earth. (Matthew 5:14; Matthew 5:16)

Lift up the volunteers, asking that they serve with compassion and intentionality, bringing the light of Jesus to each interaction. May the Turkey Drive be a place of genuine engagement, where all feel seen and loved.

Freedom Prayer Conference | November 8-9

Pray for attendees to encounter God's liberating power, breaking chains and experiencing true freedom in Christ, and for a deepening of prayer lives, both individually and corporately, leading to a more vibrant and effective church community.

Men's Ministry Cookoff | November 9

Pray for meaningful connections among participants, strengthening unity and camaraderie within the men's ministry. Ask that each man feels welcome and valued, and that the event opens doors for new friendships and opportunities for growth.
