## **Bold Love: The Courage to Kneel**

God, help us to love boldly. In this new month we are reminded how bold love prepares the way for God to move. John 13:1-15 illustrates Jesus' example for us to follow. He didn't just talk about love, he demonstrated it-down on his knees, with a basin and towel.

As we pray for Houston to experience revival, and to become a City of God, it will start with us individually. Please take time in introspection to pray...

## What does revival look like for you?

**Isaiah 57:15-**"For thus says the One who is high and lifted up, who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, and also with him who is of a contrite and lowly spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly, and to revive the heart of the contrite.

## Are there any specific sins I need to repent of?

Psalm 139:23-24- "Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!"

## PRAYER WARRIORS:

This month, we continue within the Prepare Initiative as a body. Looking at Jesus' example of loving boldly, ask the Holy Spirit to help you love others, not in theory, but in action. Ask him to open your eyes to someone who needs encouragement, care, or grace. Ask him to make your heart more open, your schedule more interruptible, your posture more like Jesus'. #### **Prayer Points**

- 1. Pray that we would have deep compassion for people. I Corinthians 13:3, Matthew 9:36
- 2. Pray we would walk in gentleness, kindness and patience. Luke 7:36-50, John 8:1-11
- 3. Pray we would express authentic love so the other person feels loved, and for it to not just be a feeling we hold to ourselves. Pray we look to Jesus' example in how to love one another. - Mark 1: 40-45, John 15:9-17, John 13:34
- 4. Pray we step into intentional and radical servanthood. John 13: 1-17, Mark 10:45
- 5. Pray for courage and boldness to say no when needed, and that our hearts would be aligned in seeking the approval of God and not man. - Gal 1:10, John 11:1-44
- 6. Pray that there is an increase in fervent prayer for others. John 17:1-16, James 5:13-16, Romans 12:12, Colossians 1:9
- 7. Pray that we would be present to listen and to understand in conversation and potential conflict. - Psalm 34:15/17, Mark 10:35-45, James 1:19, Proverbs 2:2
- 8. Pray for discernment, wisdom, and willingness to challenge one another at times. -Proverbs 15:1-2, Ephesians 4:15, Colossians 4:6
- 9. Pray for a heart to forgive those who have brought hurt. Ephesians 4:32, Mark 11:25, Matthew 6:14-15, Colossians 3:13
- 10. Pray for hearts of sacrifice for the sake of others. John 15:13, 1 John 3:16, Mark 10:45, Romans 12:1
