Prayer Guide

***We are of One Vision:
That Houston would
be a City of God.
Within this, we pray
for:***

A fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit to come:

That revival would ignite at WoodsEdge and ripple across Houston (Acts 2:17).

A unified Church in Houston:

One heart and one voice, so that our city becomes known not for problems but for the presence of God (John 17:21).

Prodigals to return home to Christ:

For Prodigals and for lukewarm believers to be set ablaze with first love again (Revelation 2:4–5).

God's kingdom to come:

Breaking chains of addiction, violence, human trafficking, and despair in our city (Isaiah 61:1–3).

A Month of Consecration and Awakening

This September we seek God with undivided hearts, asking him to consecrate us afresh, pour out His Spirit, and prepare us for revival in our church and our city.

PRAYER WARRIORS:

As we step into this new ministry year and the launch of the Prepare Initiative, we sense God calling us first to Himself. Before buildings, budgets, or plans, He desires consecrated hearts and extraordinary prayer. Let's join

together in intercession, asking God to meet us with His presence and lead us into revival.

Prayer Prompts:

1. **Consecrated Hearts** – *“Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you”* (Joshua 3:5). Pray for every member of WoodsEdge to seek God with undivided hearts and renewed devotion.
2. **Extraordinary Prayer** – *“They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness”* (Acts 4:31). Ask God to raise the prayer level in our church, beginning with each of us.
3. **Abundant Generosity** – *“Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver”* (2 Cor. 9:7). Pray for joyful, faith-filled giving that advances God's kingdom.
4. **Revival Fire** – *“Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?”* (Psalm 85:6). Cry out for revival to begin in our church and spread across Houston.
5. **Mission Expansion** – *“You will be my witnesses... to the end of the earth”* (Acts 1:8). Pray for God's favor on new church plants, local outreach, and global partnerships through WoodsEdge.
