A Guide to Pray

1. Adoration:

"Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness." **Psalms 29:2**

2. Confession:

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

1 John 1:9

- **That a relationship with Jesus Christ would be cultivated, leading to a life transformed**
 - "And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit." **2 Corinthians 3:18**
