Repent, Choose Wisely, Choose Jesus

This week's lesson is about Luke 13:6-9, 10-17, 22-30.

We discussed three accounts from Luke 13.

Luke 13:6-9

The parable of the Barren Fig Tree – “The lesson for the individual is that borrowed time is not permanent. God’s patience has a limit. In the parable, the vineyard owner grants another year of life to the tree. In the same way, God in His mercy grants us another day, another hour, another breath. Christ stands at the door of each man’s heart knocking and seeking to gain entrance and requiring repentance from sin. But if there is no fruit, no repentance, His patience will come to an end, and the fruitless, unrepentant individual will be cut down.”

Luke 13:10-17

Account of the woman with a disabling spirit (*not a parable, this actually happened*) – “Jesus healing a woman who had been crippled by a spirit for eighteen years on the Sabbath, teaching the crowd the importance of mercy and compassion over strict adherence to religious laws and rituals.”

Luke 13:22-30

The parable of ‘The Narrow Door’ - “Jesus commanded his listeners, and us, to enter and pass through a *narrow* door (or gate, or road, or path). It’s that *narrow* option that he told *everyone* to take. The reason that that’s the better choice is that it leads to *life*. The narrow door represents the path to heaven through our belief in Jesus. Otherwise, if we don’t obey his command and enter through the proper door, we’ll go through the wrong door, offering dire consequences, aka hell. There’s no third option; we must choose the narrow door or the wide one.”

Bible Verse: Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” John 14:6

Life Application: I will repent and choose Jesus.
