Elisha's Invisible Army

This week's lesson is about 2 Kings 6:8-23

The King of Syria wanted to destroy Israel. He plotted an ambush of the Israelite army that depended on secrecy. Meanwhile, God warned Elisha of the plot and Elisha sent his servant to warn the King of Israel. At every turn, the King of Syria was thwarted from conquering Israel. Finally, he decided there was a traitor in their midst. One soldier pointed out that the prophet Elisha was the likely problem because he knew things before they happened. The King of Syria decided to kidnap Elisha to keep him from warning the King of Israel. He sent his army and chariots to the city of Dothan (where Elisha lived). They surrounded the city. The next morning his servant awoke and saw the army of Syria and was very afraid. Elisha, however, wasn't worried at all for he said to his servant, 'They that are with us are more than they have with them." His servant was confused. Then Elisha said, 'They have just human power, but we have the Lord our God.' Then Elisha prayed that God would open his servant's eyes. 'Go and look out of the window again.' The young man looked. The enemy was still there, but now he saw horses and chariots of fire standing ready to defend Elisha. Then, fearlessly, Elisha walked into the midst of the whole Syrian army. 'Smite them with blindness!' he prayed. Suddenly a terrifying darkness fell upon the soldiers. They didn't know where they were and could not see. Then Elisha told them to, 'Follow me.' He led them to Samaria, the capital of Israel. A very unfriendly place for these Syrian soldiers. They were surrounded by the Israelite army. Their sight was restored and they realized they were surrounded. Elisha told the King of Israel rather than killing them they should feed them and send them back to Syria. God showed great mercy to these raiders from Syria and they never raided in Israel again.
