This week's lesson is about Luke 1:26-38; Matthew 1:18-25

To a virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David. The virgin's name was Mary. The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you." Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be. But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid Mary, you have found favor with God. You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus."

"He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High." "How will this be," Mary asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?"

The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the Holy One to be born will be called the Son of God."

Your cousin Elizabeth will have a baby too. "For nothing is impossible with God."

"I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May it be done to me as you have said." Then the angel left her.

"Mary is a good example of the kind of response to God's surprises that we should have in our own lives. ...Even though Mary knew that her life would not be what she expected it to be, she still offered herself to God in faithful, free submission."

When Joseph found out that Mary was going to have a baby he decided to break up with her. He was ashamed that she was going to have a baby because they were not living as a married couple yet. But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home to be his wife.

To the world, the faithfulness of Joseph may seem foolish, but to those who are willing to follow his example and surrender their wills to the will of God, the faithfulness of Joseph is not simply a way of pleasing God; it's a way of fulfilling your own life's destiny.
