


CARE This Week...

The Plot Against Jesus

This week's lesson is about **Matthew 26:1-5, 14-16; Mark 14:1-2, 10-11; Luke 22:1-6; John 11:45-53**

News of Jesus raising Lazarus to life reaches Jerusalem. Many people believe in Jesus but others report what He has done to the religious leaders. Then the chief priests and the elders of the people met together in the palace of the high priest, who was named Caiaphas. At this meeting, they discussed Jesus. 'Jesus performs a lot of miracles.' 'If we let this continue, everyone will believe in Him and the Romans will take action against us! They'll destroy our temple and our nation.' Caiaphas, the high priest, spoke up, 'It's better that one man dies for the nation than that all are destroyed. So, this Jesus has to be killed! They planned to arrest Jesus by stealth and kill Him. But they said, 'Not during the feast, so that there won't be a riot among the people.' One man has to die for all men! The religious leaders look for an opportunity to catch Jesus. They are on the lookout for Him. They plan to arrest Jesus and then get the Romans to sentence Him to death. Meanwhile, When Jesus had finished teaching about the future judgment of the nations, He told His disciples, 'You know that after two days the Passover is coming, and the Son of Man will be handed over to be crucified.' Enter Judas...Satan has entered into Judas and he now wants to betray Jesus. (Luke 22:3) Judas went to the chief priests and said, 'What will you give me to betray Him into your hands?' They weigh out thirty pieces of silver to Judas. It was the price of a slave. From then on Judas begins to look for a good opportunity to betray Jesus.


In this account we learn a lesson about loyalty. Loyalty means to be faithful and devoted...to give or show firm and constant support (allegiance) to another person or institution. Our job is to remain loyal, faithful and devoted to God the father and Jesus the son. Judas failed in his loyalty to Jesus. He is an example of what NOT to do.

Bible Verse: Never let loyalty and faithfulness leave you. Proverbs 3:3
