Esther

This week's lesson is about Esther 7-9

We finished our study of Esther. A book of the Bible that teaches us many lessons: **God is always at work.** Even when we cannot see Him working, God is still in control.

God has a purpose for us. Esther was placed in a special position where she could help God's people.

Be courageous. Esther was afraid, but she chose to do what was right.

Pray and seek God's guidance. Esther asked the Jewish people to fast before she approached the king.

Use what God has given you to help others. Esther used her position as queen to protect her people.

Pride can lead to destruction. Haman's pride and desire for honor eventually led to his downfall.

Do not live for the approval of others. Haman had wealth, power, and honor, but he was still unhappy because Mordecai would not honor him.

Trust God when circumstances are difficult. Esther and Mordecai faced a situation that seemed hopeless, but they continued to act faithfully.

Our choices matter. Esther, Mordecai, Haman, and King Xerxes all made their own choices, yet God accomplished His purpose through what happened.

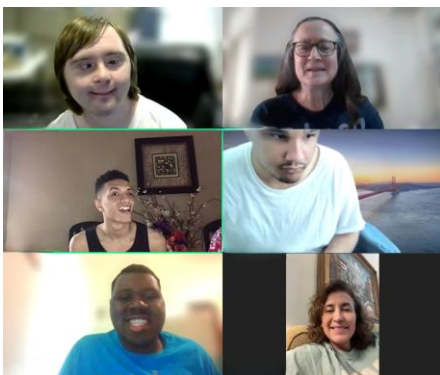
Serve others, not yourself. Esther risked her own safety to save others. Her example reminds us to use our freedom and opportunities to serve people in love.

Bible Verse: For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. Galatians 5:13

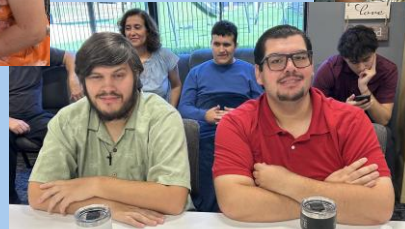
Life Application: I will choose to follow God's ways.
