At the June 18, 2024 Session meeting:

- Rev. Ariel Mink is now a member of the Presbytery of the Redwoods, effective June 2, 2024 at her worship and ordination service.
- An Elder Retreat is scheduled for Saturday, August 24, 2024 where initiatives and goals will be reviewed and updated in planning for the 2024/2025 program year.
- An Elder/Deacon/Committee Chair/Committee Member retreat will be held on Sunday, August 25, 2024, after worship to focus on:
  - Unveiling of a theme, goals, and/or priorities for the program year 2024/2025 and initiatives developed by Session on August 24, 2024.

- Accepted and reviewed the Wholistic Music Program report prepared by the Task Force. Session thanked the Task Force members for their work.

- The Safety-Emergency and Property Committees continue to perform walk-throughs of the church campus to comply with insurance and fire requirements. Session members will assist with a final walk-through if needed.


go to church with you, to be exchanged for other fascinating challenges.

## **Adult Christian Learning Opportunity**



Christian Education committee is sponsoring a new -Summer 2024 adult learning opportunity: "God Against The Gods", a series of twelve video lectures free via Zoom that presents the discovery, translation, and significance of ancient scrolls found at Qumran, in 1947. The videos are produced by The Teaching Company as one of its "Great Courses" series, and feature Dr. Robert Garland, Ph.D., professor of Classics and ancient history at Colgate University.

Weekly sessions will cover two lectures and discussion led by Walt Campbell. Six sessions are scheduled for Saturdays at 10:30 AM, from June 15 to July 28. Please see the PCN website or email Walt Campbell to enroll. This opportunity is open to non-members. New participants can join at any time, and easily catch up by reading the study guide for earlier lectures.

Participants will receive a pdf file of the course guide and a weekly email with suggested discussion questions and listening highlights for the upcoming Saturday session. Start your summer with a bit of comparative religion.
