GOODNESS in G minor

According to Abraham Heschel (Jewish Scholar and author of "The Prophets"), "The prophet is human, yet he employs notes one octave too high for our ears. He experiences moments that defy our understanding. He is neither 'a singing saint' nor 'a moralizing poet,' but an assaulter of the mind. Often his words begin to burn where conscience ends."

Over the next month at North Main we will continue to explore the Minor Prophets in the Old Testament. These prophets, called by GOD to speak on His behalf to the nation of Israel, and the surrounding nations, would be rejected, persecuted, and executed for their prophecies. Incensed by their words, the people of GOD and the pagan nations, worked diligently to ignore, mock, and slander the prophets of GOD. Made out to be fools, the prophets stand in a league of their own, pointing out the injustices and violence perpetrated by those who opposed GOD and His commands. Truth be told, however, the fools were those who sought to silence the ones called by GOD to proclaim the truth and give warnings to the people.

The Apostle Paul, who some would call not only an evangelist for the Gospel of Christ but also a prophet, wrote these words to the church in Corinth: "God chose things the world considers foolish in order to shame those who think they are wise. And he chose things that are powerless to shame those who are powerful. God chose things despised by the world, things counted as nothing at all, and used them to bring to nothing what the world considers important" (1 Corinthians 1:27-28). There are echoes in Paul's writing in the Proverbs: "Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD, and turn away from evil" (Proverbs 3:7 NRSV). These two passages affirm that the wisdom of those to whom the prophets spoke was riddled with holes and founded on a faulty foundation. Worldly wisdom convinces people that faith is foolish, but Godly wisdom always leads to the truth. However, unless a person/people are willing to recognize this within themselves, and hear the prophet of GOD and heed his warning, the voice of the prophet falls on deaf ears, thus, leading to imminent judgment and punishment.

In conclusion, Heschel writes, "It is embarrassing to be a prophet. There are so many pretenders, predicting peace and prosperity, offering cheerful words, and adding strength to self-reliance, while the prophet predicts disaster, pestilence, agony, and destruction. People need exhortations to courage, endurance, confidence, fighting spirit, but Jeremiah proclaims: You are about to die if you do not have a change of heart and cease being callous to the word of GOD."

GOD still calls prophets today. Are we (GOD's people) heeding their warnings, and turning our hearts and minds back to GOD in repentance and worship? Have we compromised our faith and become calloused to the word of GOD? It's time to wake up, for our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed (Romans 13:11).


