DIGGING DEEPER

- 6. James 4:8 also speaks of confronting specific sins that have crept into our hearts. How can we know what those are? Why is this so important?
- 7. **Read James 4:9.** Is God calling us to be spiritual Sad Sacks or something different? Why is this attitude toward the sin in our hearts so important?
- 8. **Read James 4:10.** What is the Lord lifting us up from? What is he lifting us up to? Why is humility a prerequisite to this?
