## **DIGGING DEEPER**

- 1. What does it mean that Jesus possesses "all authority in heaven and on earth?"

- 4. Why did Jesus extend the invitation to join His Kingdom to all nations? How does this truth confront all forms of racism and prejudice?
- 5. **Read Revelation 7:9-10.** According to these verses (and Acts 1:8), how will Jesus' mission to all nations succeed?
- 6. Why did Jesus emphasize that disciples must be taught to obey "all that I have commanded you?"
- 7. Why do so many people treat some of the commands of Jesus as optional instead of obligatory? What are some of the commands of Jesus that you find most difficult to obey in your own life?
- 8. Why did Jesus promise His presence would be with His disciples for all of time?
- 9. How can the presence of Jesus serve to strengthen and provide hope as you set out to fulfill His Great Commission?
- 10. What are some ways that you can become more involved and invested in the Great Commission of Jesus?
- 11. In what ways do you need to be better equipped as a disciple? In what ways are you ready/not ready to make disciples?
