DIGGING DEEPER

1. Peter denied Jesus three times, yet Jesus gave him a threefold opportunity to affirm his love (vv. 15–17). Why do you think Jesus asked Peter the same question three times?
2. What does this say about Jesus' approach to failure?
3. How does forgiveness differ from excusing or forgetting failure?
4. How can we reflect this kind of forgiving spirit in our own relationships?
5. What role does genuine repentance play in healing and restoration in both our spiritual lives and human relationships?
6. What does it mean to follow Jesus faithfully in the face of hardship or uncertainty?
7. What specific areas of your life might Jesus be calling you to deeper faithfulness today?
8. In verses 20–22, Peter asks about John's future. Jesus responds, "What is that to you? You must follow me." Why do you think Jesus rebuked Peter's question?
9. How can comparison to others distract or discourage us in our calling?
10. What practices help you stay focused on your own walk with Christ instead of comparing it to others?
11. How can you resist the trap of comparison and remain committed to God's calling for your life?
