DIGGING DEEPER

- 1. **Read 1 Samuel 18:1–9.** How did Jonathan's actions toward David demonstrate respect for God's plan? How did Saul's jealousy reveal resistance to God's rule?
- 2. Why do some people celebrate when God works in someone else's life, while others become resentful?
- 3. Are you more like Jonathan (supporting God's work in others) or Saul (feeling threatened)?
- 4. **Read 1 Samuel 18:10–12.** How did God's presence with David strengthen him and unsettle Saul?
- 5. Where in your life have you experienced God's presence bringing courage or peace?
- 6. Why does the absence of God's presence bring fear or instability?
- 7. How can you cultivate a greater awareness of God's presence in life?
- 8. How do these New Testament passages connect to David's story in 1 Samuel 18?
- 9. What does it mean that God can take rejection and resistance and turn them into redemption and rejoicing?
- 10. Where is God asking you to remain faithful even in opposition?
- 11. How do we see God guiding and providing for David in this chapter?
- 12. What does this truth mean when you are uncertain about the future?
- 13. How can trusting God to guide change how you make decisions?
- 14. Where in your life do you need to lean on God's guidance and provision right now?
