Five Ways To Leave A Living Legacy Of Faithfulness To God!
1 Timothy 4:12-16, NKJV

¹² Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity. ¹³ Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. ¹⁴ Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership. ¹⁵ Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all. ¹⁶ Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you.

- **Teach With Your Life** - ¹² Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.
 - Aim to be a good, godly and growing example of a Christian in your conversations, conduct, compassion, character, convictions and cleanliness!

- **Love The Word Of God** - ¹³ Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.
 - What we seek to do each week as we gather for worship at New Life Church!
 - * Read Scripture publicly
 - * Encourage you the listener
 - * Teach you the meaning of the passage

- **Use It Or Lose It** - ¹⁴ Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership.
 - Highly skilled and talented athletes lose their effectiveness if their muscles aren't exercised!
 - We lose the effectiveness, impact, sharpness, of our spiritual gifts when neglected!

- **Experience More Deeply The Lord Jesus Christ** - ¹⁵ Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all.
