³⁴ But when the Pharisees heard that He had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together.
³⁵ Then one of them, a lawyer, asked *Him a question,* testing Him, and saying, ³⁶ "Teacher, which *is* the great commandment in the law?" ³⁷ Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' ³⁸ This is *the* first and great commandment. ³⁹ And *the* second *is* like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' ⁴⁰ On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets." *Matthew 22:34-40, NKJV*
