#### II. Isolation as result of the pandemic

- A. Birth of Zoom
  - 1. 65% of regular in-person church-goers report being "connected."
  - 2. Only 22% of virtual viewers feel connected to other worshippers.
- B. Hard to be the body of Christ on line.
  - 1. Nationally, In-person attendance has declined.
  - 2. On-line viewership initially surged yet has now declined.

III. Global News, Inc. labeled loneliness as a "health crisis."

- A. US Surgeon General's report calls loneliness a "national pandemic."

The most frequent word translated parakeleo, means to come to one's side," "to all to one's aid, Consolation or comfort" (23x) (Gal 6:2, Jas 1:19) Suggested verbiage: <u>"How are things going with you?"</u></li> </ul>

Word ἐπιστήμων used as in "encourage/exhort" (23x) as in Heb 3:12-13 If there is a problem, God should be part of the solution. <u>This is where we encourage a course of action: "Keep the faith or</u> <u>keep up the good work" or "Let's pray about this."</u></li> <li>C. Instruct (2 Tim 3:16a) All Scripture is profitable for teaching, reproof,</li> </ul>
