"Starting The Ride"

All people, whether consciously or unconsciously, have a code of basic understanding. It is commonly called our world view. That world view has a bearing on all we think and do, for it is the underlying assumption we make when approaching any matter of thought or action.

The Christian World View has as its starting point, God is Creator. The following verses, although not used as part of today's message, speak of this starting point of all that exists:

"For by Him (God) all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, ... all things have been created by Him and for Him." Colossians 1:16

"Thou alone art the Lord, Thou hast made the heavens, the heaven of heavens with all their hosts. The earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them. Thou dost give life to all of them. And the heavenly hosts bow down before Thee. Thou art the Lord God." Nehemiah 9:6

"Our help is in the name of the Lord, Who made heaven and earth." Psalm 124:8

And a verse that tells the intended results:

"Worthy art thou, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for Thou didst create all things, and because of Thy will they existed and were created." Revelation 4:11

So what is the alternative world view? That all things just "happened", or, just made themselves?
