

AMBASSADORS FOR CHRIST! (Hold Your Head Up High)

2 Corinthians 5:14-21, NKJV

¹⁴ For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died; ¹⁵ and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again. ¹⁶ Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know *Him thus* no longer. ¹⁷ Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. ¹⁸ Now all things *are* of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, ¹⁹ that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. ²⁰ Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore *you* on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. ²¹ For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

HOLD YOUR HEAD UP HIGH AS AN ABASSADOR!

1. The Marks Of An Ambassador For Christ!

An ambassador is an official representative from one country to another. Ambassadors of the United States are persons nominated by the president to serve as diplomatic representatives to foreign nations. They are the highest-ranking diplomats of the U.S. and are usually based at the embassy in the host country.

- \Rightarrow <u>Knowledge</u> We need to know the central message of God's Kingdom and something about how to respond to the obstacles that we will encounter on our diplomatic mission.
- \Rightarrow <u>Wisdom</u> Our knowledge must be tempered with the kind of wisdom that makes our message attractive, clear and persuasive. This requires the tools of a diplomat, not the weapons of a warrior, tactical skill rather than brute force.
- \Rightarrow <u>Character</u> This will make or break our mission. Knowledge and Wisdom are packaged in a person. If we do not embody the virtues of the Kingdom we serve, we will undermine our message and handicap our effectiveness.

2. The Message Of An Ambassador For Christ! - 2 Corinthians 5:18-21, NLT

¹⁸ And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him. ¹⁹ For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. ²⁰ So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" ²¹ For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

3. The Motivation Of An Ambassador For Christ!

 \Rightarrow The Love Of Christ - 2 Corinthians 5:14-15, NKJV

¹⁴ For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died; ¹⁵ and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.

 \Rightarrow The Judgement Seat Of Christ - 2 Corinthians 5:9-10, NKJV

⁹ Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him. ¹⁰ For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things *done* in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

 \Rightarrow The Greatest Need Of The Lost - 2 Corinthians 5:11, NKJV

¹¹ Knowing, therefore, the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are well known to God, and I also trust are well known in your consciences.
