FAITH PROMISE MISSIONARY UPDATES

Zuercher, Kirk & Julie - China Outreach Ministries

A new school year has begun and the COM staff are welcoming new Chinese students and scholars to their ministries. For many of the COM missionaries, that includes things like: airport pickups; welcome picnics and BBQs; local sight-seeing trips; taking them shopping and to the bank so they can open a bank account; and furniture giveaway events so they can furnish their apartment. "As we look back on the past school year, we know that there are close to 300,000 Chinese students and scholars who are here studying in the US. COM missionaries are on 55 campuses around the country. This means that around 55,000 Chinese were on the campuses where we have a COM presence. 4,700 Chinese were exposed to the gospel and a little over 200 of them came to know Christ. The number of students in discipleship relationship with COM staff is the second highest level since COM started tracking this data 2 decades ago. Praise be to God! As we look to this new school year and make our plans, please keep us in prayer. We want to see more and more of these students come to know Christ and follow Him for the rest of their lives. We cannot do it without you giving and praying for all of us. May we all be fruitful in sowing the seeds of the Gospel and faithful in doing our part as God calls." Kirk & Julie shared about their Southeast Area Retreat from Sept 19 thru 21 at St. Christopher's Camp & Conference Center in Seabrook Island, SC. They enjoyed a great time of fellowship, singing, praying for each other's needs and learning from John Maxwell and Luie Giglio using online teaching videos. "So glad for technology these days." In May, their 3rd grandson, Hudson was born to Kevin & Sarah. And in May, they traveled to Aruba to celebrate their 35th wedding anniversary. During their time in Aruba, "We had the wonderful surprise to see a family from Alabama that we had not seen in over 15 years. Who would have thought that we would meet at a restaurant in Aruba? It just reminds us of the saying that we often teach our Chinese friends, "It's a small, small world."

Lorow, Ken & Eileen - ABWE - Director of Prefield Ministries

The Lorows spent two weeks on the road together—speaking at missions conferences, visiting pastors in their sending churches, encouraging prefielders and participating in a commissioning service. Their travels took them through Ohio, Michigan, Iowa and other states along the way. One of the first families the Lorows had the privilege of walking alongside in the Prefield journey was Amanda & Aaron. They "had the joy of participating in their commissioning service—a powerful time of worship, prayer, and celebration with their family and home church. It was such a blessing to rejoice with them and their sending church as they prepare to launch into their field of service in early November. Seeing how God has faithfully prepared, provided for, and guided them through this season is a beautiful reminder of His steadfastness and the power of the Body of Christ working together for the sake of the gospel." The road trip also allowed them to connect with others in the prefield stage and participate in a special gather for some of their retired missionaries. Upon their return home, Ken & Eileen are having some special family time filled with laughter, good conversation, and memory-making with three of their children, one daughter-in-law, and their two grandsons. "Thank you, as always, for walking alongside us through your prayers and support. We're so grateful to have you on this journey with us!"

Timblin Jr, Paul & Laurel - UIM Aviation

Paul & Laurel are back home in Tucson "after a LOT of summer ministry travel. We spoke at 19 different churches! Besides that, we had 47 small group meetings. That math adds up to 66 speaking times while covering 9,585 miles. We slept in 20 different beds...thank you to all who housed us." Gabriel and Ruth were married on May 31st. It was a beautiful day of celebration. Ruth's father gave the wedding message in Portuguese (they are Brazilian) so her grandmother could understand. Ruth's brother translated for everyone else. They are beyond thankful for Ruth and her parents who love the Lord and seek to know Him. Their family experienced a Chickenpox saga during the time of the wedding. Some could attend, some couldn't, some were exposed and other's were not. Matthew & Karizma drove all the way from San Diego and were not able to be around the kids which was "the saddest thing ever". "My mom turns 90 this month, and for the first time in 10 years, all of my siblings were in the USA. So, we had a family reunion / birthday party! There were over 50 of us there and it was so wonderful." The Timblins are off again - this time to Germany where they will speak in a new church and update the supporters they have there. Paul will also have the opportunity to share at the Bible School where his parents ministered for many years. Paul's parents and three siblings live in Germany so Paul & Laurel will take this opportunity to spend some time with them as well. They end with "...thank you for your prayers, encouragement and giving so we can be here working with UIM Aviation."

Hawes, Tim & Leandra - ABWE - Papua New Guinea

The Hawes begin by sharing about two young men. "Praise God, Tim was able to pray with a young man named Terry from the church plant at Sagifa, who accepted Christ as his Savior. There is also a young man in the church who confessed his involvement with the evil spirits. After counseling, his prayer was so sincere, but please pray earnestly for Billy as he is fighting a battle that will only be won in God's strength." Many people are helping with the curriculum for the Bible clubs. They ask that we pray as they seek to complete the curriculum review with the next few months, with the goal of possible digital distribution in early 2026. "Please also be in prayer, as our curriculum has been reviewed by the Education Department and is now awaiting their October Board of Studies meeting for the possible approval as a recognized resource book." 5,000 teachers' Bibles have been ordered and paid for in a large part due to the generosity of Ministry Asia. They end with "Lastly, we continue to battle so many health issues on top of Tim's stomach issues, Leandra and Lydia's celiac disease, and now Leandra's dairy intolerance. Please pray that we can be healthy to serve the Lord. We are so grateful for you all!"

Caputo, John & Kim - Gospel Furthering Fellowship - Millersville & West Chester Univ.

Their update begins with "Even before the news of Charlie Kirk's tragic death and glorious celebration of life, the Lord caused students to respond to the efforts made weeks before with various promotional efforts. For those of you who have been praying, the Lord has used your efforts to advance ministry efforts at both Millersville and West Chester Universities. We have enjoyed having many new visitors come to the studies as well as the faithful attendance of our regulars." September 11th was a unique day as three students professed faith in Jesus Christ on the same day! Prayer requests are: 1) For the WCU outreach to continue to grow under Kyle's leadership, 2) Travis & Tiffany continue to be a great blessing and asset to our ministry. Please pray for them during this transitional time, 3) Pray for the continued advancement of our new "small prayer group ministry" which is allowing more of our leaders to gain valuable experience in sharing God's Word and leading in prayer, and 4) Salvation of new students that I will be visiting with soon.

Hoagland, Ed & Annita - BBF - Mexico City

This month Ed & Annita "celebrate 41 years of living and working for Jesus Christ in Mexico City. God has allowed us to plant 10 churches, currently overseeing 7 missions that become a self-supporting church after 5 years, have a Bible College with 140 graduates and 20 current students, a Christian elementary school with 40 students, 4 Manna feeding centers, and many evangelistic events." The small group ministry has been revamped and Annita has almost 200 people signed up in 33 small groups that will be meeting during the week and weekends beginning this month. "It's Good News to let you know that the financial goal for our Evangelistic Events for next year and the total amount for the slides project has completely been met. Thank you for your prayers and for all who gave to help us with these needs. Now let's get to work. Jesus is coming soon." On Friday, Oct 10th, Ed married a couple and presented the gospel to their friends and family members. "God answered our prayers and there were 14 who called on Jesus to be saved." There have been heavy rains in Mexico for several weeks with several communities being flooded resulting in several deaths and severe damage to homes and churches, some completely destroyed. "We have decided to make the 5 hr trip over there next Wednesday (10/22) to help the churches in all the work they're doing to clean up and minister to the people. We'll be renting a bus and taking over 40 people with us to help give out food, clothes & water. But we'll also be doing a few evangelistic events where we plan to give them some words of hope during these difficult times. Pray for us as we give all we have to minister to the needy. God bless."

Serino, Nick & Darianne - North Slope Baptist Mission - Alaskan Arctic

Nick begins by sharing that his "check up and blood work at the Mayo Clinic went great! This is, of course, due to your prayers and the mercy and grace of our blessed Savior! Thank you all for being so faithful. No biopsy or scans needed until next November! God is so good!" They are currently in Fairbanks for a few doctor appointments and will be returning to Pt. Hope by the end of the month. As for their time in the lower 48, "All of our meetings went great! Most of the churches we visited haven't seen us in 13 yrs or longer so it was truly a glad reunion to see faithful prayer warriors again!" Nick says their trip was exhausting as they covered over 13,000 driving miles in 8 weeks. NLC was one of the churches they visited on their trip.

Beard, Sam & Megan - BBF - Jeju Island, South Korea

The Beards begin by saying the summer was a whirlwind of activity. July was serving at a youth camp for missionary kids. Over 200 teens and young adult MKs came from 42 different mission fields. Megan led training for staff, workshops for middle school, and they both spent 4 days with the graduating seniors. In August they hosted a series of workshops at Nations Baptist which was the best attended community event they have done. Several of the guests have since attended a Sunday service. In September, Megan completed her 5-year course of hormone treatments to reduce the risk of breast cancer recurrence and all is clear! The Beards ask that we pray for Andre & Jieun, a middle school brother and sister who have been attending the kids classes for the past 2 years. "Their mother is terminally ill and they are seeking to understand the questions of life and death. Please pray for Andre, Jieun, and their parents to clearly understand the gospel."

"A Big Reveal: we are looking for a permanent home for our Shin Jeju location!" In August, one of our leadership families developed a 5-year ministry plan to establish a non-profit business that will also provide a meeting space for our services on Sunday and small groups during the week. Since real estate prices in the city area major barrier to the church having its own space, this partnership will offset rental costs for the church and position us to have a much greater impact with a daily presence in the community. Please pray that God will lead us to the right property. Additionally, will you prayerfully consider a special offering to help with the deposit for the property? We are trying to raise the deposit money, which will be around \$50,000. The deposit is fully refundable, which means we can reuse it for another deposit at the end of the 5-year period. Our goal is to find a location by December and be in the new space by January." Sam & Megan thank everyone for your partnership to engage the nations with the gospel from Jeju.

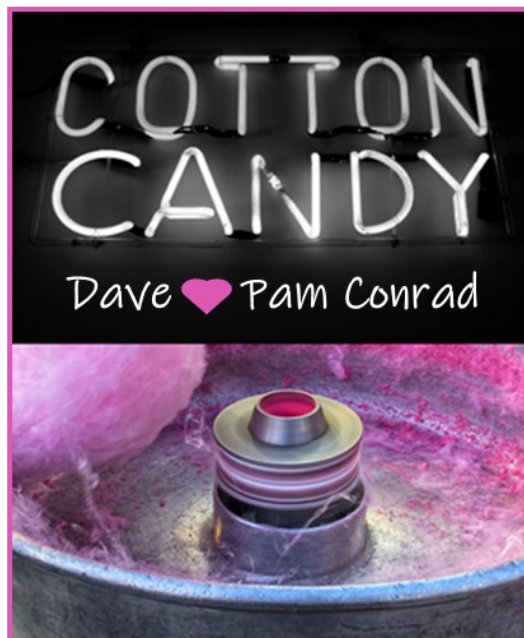

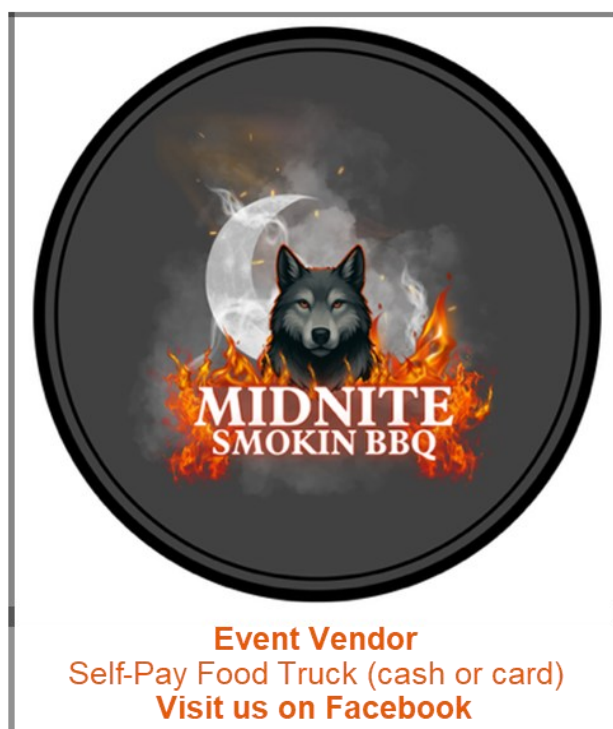

“Life in the Body”
Ephesians 4:1-16, ESV

October 19, 2025

4 I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, ² with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, ³ eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. ⁴ There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism, ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all. ⁷ But grace was given to each one of us according to the measure of Christ's gift. ⁸ Therefore it says, “When he ascended on high he led a host of captives, and he gave gifts to men.” ⁹ (In saying, “He ascended,” what does it mean but that he had also descended into the lower regions, the earth? ¹⁰ He who descended is the one who also ascended far above all the heavens, that he might fill all things.) ¹¹ And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, ¹² to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, ¹³ until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ, ¹⁴ so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes. ¹⁵ Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, ¹⁶ from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love.
