<u>Timblin, Paul & Laurel - UIM Aviation</u>

Laurel shares that "2024 was welcomed with all of our kids home this time! ... For many parts of the world, 2024 finds their lands in a terrible situation. As I follow the news (which is unusual for me) I have a stronger sense of urgency. My goal for this year is a deeper knowledge of the Lord and deeper relationships with those God places in my life. Thank you for praying for us and any encouraging emails, texts and calls now and then. Of course we appreciate the financial support as well and that you choose to be used by the Lord in providing for us and this ministry here. In the past 6 months our account has been lower than usual as several of our faithful supports moved to Heaven. I try to imagine them there... I'm sure that my imagination doesn't even begin to touch the joy and beauty they are seeing and experiencing! ... We work diligently to do what God has called us to do and share His story of salvation for all who choose."

Foltz, Joanne - Tanzania

Joanne begins with 'God wants us to see this new year as "His coming is closer." Many have told us for years that we were in the end days. Well, we are closer to the "Last Days" and we need to be busy telling others about His coming. We need to be faithful in telling the Good New of Jesus to a lost, dying world. As we look at the days of Noah, today is as bad or worse. Our friends, family, colleagues, and others who we meet each day need a Savior! Let us be faithful to tell them this new year of 2024." Joanne is currently on furlough in Florida. She is thankful not to be living out of a suitcase as she is being housed by Winter Haven Baptist Church. Joanne asks that we continue to pray for her travels and health. "Sickness seems to be many places but I have been spared several times. God is so good to me." Rardin, Clint & Rhonda - Mexico City, Mexico

The Rardins are very excited about so many new families coming to the church in the last few months. They come from an 83-building apartment complex located behind their church building. (The Rardins walk through the complex to the church from their home every day.) It is exciting for them to see they are reaching their own immediate neighborhood as well as families of routes and missions further away. "It is good to see we are truly a local church." Recently "a soldier from another state who was getting chemotherapy at the nearby military hospital, was invited by one of our military doctors. He trusted Christ as his Savior and asked for a church he could attend... We gladly gave him the addresses of three churches." The update ends with "Thank you for your faithful economic support and prayers. God is answering our prayers."

Bennett, Dan & Becky - Sao Paulo, Brazil

The Bennetts begin by thanking everyone with gratitude for "holding the ropes" for us prayerfully and financially for many years...some for more than 25 years." They share the story of a deaf couple that Dan recently had the privilege to baptize after they trusted Chris as Savior. They had been invited to church by one of their deaf men that unexpectedly passed away last year. The couple have been so faithful and were excited to follow the Lord in believer's baptism. He had a huge smile on his face and she shed tears of joy after they were baptized. Their update ends with "Thank you for allowing us to represent you in the city of Sao Paulo."

Parschauer Sr, Bob & Mary Anne - WOL International

On January 10th, Bob & Mary Anne left Florida for Poland. Ministry was upon them right away with a weekend retreat for Polish youth leaders. They came from churches all over the country. The building was alive with people, music, peaching, mingling, conversations and laughter. Next was English 4 Life classes. This time there are 6 students and 2 teachers, which is much more personal. Bob & Mary Anne "were blessed to attend the Operation Christmas Child event for teens at the local youth group. Because of the gift distribution there were about 30 youth that had never been there before. This was encouraging and exciting for the regular teens and their leaders." At church "there was a testimony of a man who grew up for 20 years in a Ukrainian orphanage." His salvation experience is very interesting! He and some friends wanted to make some money Christmas caroling. A man invited them in, listened to their singing, and asked them if they knew what they were singing about. He shared the Gospel with them, and he accepted the Lord as Saviour!" They shared about Viktoria who is special to them. They met her last year at snow camp. "We sat at a table chatting with her via a translator. She was very bitter, and told us she hated God and knew she was going to hell and didn't care. Her friend Sophia was visiting from Ukraine (both are Ukrainian) and said that if Viktoria became a Christian, it would be the end of their friendship. That night Anita led Viktoria to faith in Jesus. It is amazing to see the change in her. She has blossomed, and served on camp crew all summer."

<u>Ishler, Darin & Kathy - Durba, South Africa</u>

The Ishlers begin with being blessed at having Tyler in Durban with them for Christmas. This month Kathy and Alexis will bring Ella back to the US. The will be visiting colleges, finding her a job and helping to plan a bridal shower for a dear friend. "There will be many emotions as we leave her with grandparents and head back to Durban in March. Please pray for all of us as we figure out this new chapter." The Ishlers are praising the Lord for the awesome work He is doing in the lives of the youth and young adults. The school reopened and youth group started back up, there were 30 teenagers! "What a privilege it is to be your Gospel ambassadors in Durban, South Africa!" Prayer requests: 1) We have not heard any update on our visa status, 2) Pray for Darin while he is alone for 4 weeks, 3) Pastor Dennis and Violet's health, and 4) New teammates. Praises: 1) Darin's back pain is improving from his torn disc, 2) New supporting church, 3) Tyler made the Dean's list, 4) Took 18 youth and 6 counselors to Senior Youth Camp.

<u>Daku, Paul & Martha - Fiji</u>

The Dakus share that since their return from the US in November, seven have trusted Christ. They had a wedding in December and another in January when their national pastor Brother Pau, got married to the woman of God's choosing. Alyssa was praying for eight years to marry someone who would serve the Lord and Pau prayed for many years for a wife who would serve beside him in the ministry. They got married one weekend and moved to Raki Raki the next week to begin their ministry at the Solid Rock Baptist Church there, the Daku's new baby church. In December, Paul had the joy of baptizing the first 6 people in the new church and baptistry at Solid Rock. Paul & Martha ask us to "pray about the annex building for the Lautoka church which is needed for Sunday School rooms, youth activities, etc. The Lord has provided \$16,600 as of this writing for this new building. (We till lack \$33,400 to reach our goal of \$50,000). We are praying the Lord will provide so the construction can begin later this year. Pray for this need and that the building plans will be approved soon by City Council.

Five Qualifications For Older Widows!

1 Timothy 5:3-10, NKJV

Honor True Widows

³ Honor widows who are really widows. ⁴ But if any widow has children or grandchildren, let them first learn to show piety at home and to repay their parents; for this is good and acceptable before God. ⁵ Now she who is really a widow, and left alone, trusts in God and continues in supplications and prayers night and day. ⁶ But she who lives in pleasure is dead while she lives. ⁷ And these things command, that they may be blameless. ⁸ But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever. ⁹ Do not let a widow under sixty years old be taken into the number, *and not unless* she has been the wife of one man, ¹⁰ well reported for good works: if she has brought up children, if she has lodged strangers, if she has washed the saints' feet, if she has relieved the afflicted, if she has diligently followed every good work.

1. They Are Without Human Support - ³ Honor widows who are really widows. ⁴ But if any widow has children or grandchildren, let them first learn to show piety at home and to repay their parents; for this is good and acceptable before God. ⁵ Now she who is really a widow, and left alone, ⁸ But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever. (vs 5:3-5a, 8)

2. <u>They Are A Believer With A Faithful Testimony</u> - trusts in God and continues in supplications and prayers night and day. ⁶ But she who lives in pleasure is dead while she lives. ⁷ And these things command, that they may be blameless. (vs 5:5b-7)

3. They Are At Least Sixty Years Old - $^9\mathrm{Do}$ not let a widow under sixty years old be taken into the number, (vs 5:9a)
4. They Have A Good Marriage Record - and not unless she has been the wife of one man, (vs 5:9b)
5. They Have A Testimony Of Good Works - ¹⁰ well reported for good works: if she has brought up children, if she has lodged strangers, if she has washed the saints' feet, if she has relieved the afflicted, if she has diligently followed every good work. (vs 5:10)
Five Practical Reflections And Applications
 How can New Life Church care and honor more intentionally our widows? Are there widows in your own life that you need to reach out to and support? Can you name any specific prayer concerns for at least one member of New Life? Do you know any widows in our church? Do Paul's commands also apply to widowers? How would their situation be the same? How could it be different?
