FAITH PROMISE MISSIONARY UPDATES

Lorow, Ken & Eileen - ABWE Director of Prefield Ministries

The Lorows begin by thanking everyone for their prayers during the ABWE Global Leadership Summit. They were encouraged by the meaningful connections made there. They also shared about a recent message at church that "was a powerful reminder of two truths that often sit side by side in tension: how great our sin truly is and how much greater Jesus is. The weight of our sin can feel overwhelming, but the beauty of the Gospel is that Jesus' love, grace, and forgiveness are infinitely greater. ... Isn't it incredible to know that there's no depth too deep, no sin too dark, and no shame too heavy that Jesus' sacrifice and love can't overcome? This is the hope we carry, and it's the message we have the privilege of sharing with the world." Last week on their way to Indiana for Biblical Counseling training, Ken & Eileen "had the joy of stopping in Ohio to visit our son and his family. One of the highlights was joining them for a combined birthday party for our grandsons, who just turned 4 and 2! It was a special time of celebration, laughter, and making memories together." The Lorows would appreciate our prayers for wisdom and growth as they learn to better serve others through biblical counsel. They trust God will use this time to equip and strengthen them for the ministry ahead. "Thank you for walking with us in prayer and support."

Custodio, Maicon & Leticia - WOL - Spain

The Custodios start their update with "We begin the year of 2025 with many challenges but with the certainty that we can always trust Him because we live by faith and not by sight." They shared the following prayer requests: 1) Mobilization of the Eternity 5 Million evangelism project in April; 2) Join the Cause in Leon & Toledo in March; 3) For the Snow Camp season in February; 4) Wisdom for discipleship in Spain (10) & Europe (18); 5) Health and provision for the family. In particular for our eldest daughter, Sarah, who is preparing to go to study at the Bible Institute; 6) We thank God for His goodness and faithfulness. They end with "Thank you for your prayers for our family and for the Cause of the Gospel in Spain and Europe."

Daku, Paul & Martha - BIMI - Fiji

The Dakus begin with "There Is Joy In Serving Jesus: Sometimes we look at ourselves and express how much joy we find in serving the Lord here in Fiji. We are thankful for the grace of God which has kept us here for all these years. Our hearts are grateful for your part in praying and giving so we can minister in this needy place. We are expecting great things from God in the new year!" In October 2024, Hope for Fiji services were held with Evangelist Chris Miller. Services were held in 5 towns & cities with more than 50 people trusting Christ in the meetings. One of the features of these crusades was to invite the First Responders to attend. They each were given a special Bible and other gifts. Several trusted Christ. Paul is working to arrange a Bible study with the firemen in Lautoka. "Fijians openly respect God and receive the Word of God, but in many cases, have never heard a clear presentation of the Gospel." A three day Mini Refresher Camp was held for teens in January. There were 54 campers and a total of 80 including pastors, staff and younger children. Many were here for the first time. They came from 6 different churches on the island and 14 campers accepted Christ. The Dakus ask us to pray for their son: "Please pray for our son, Scot, who is also a missionary here in Fiji with his family. They returned to the US last November due to Scot's on-going health concerns. Please pray they will be led to the right doctors and for complete healing. "Thank you to those who so graciously and generously gave us a Christmas offering. We were encouraged and blessed by your generosity. Thank you for your sacrifice and your love! We enjoyed a lovely island Christmas, even though we had much rain and flooding during that week."

Ishler, Darin & Kathy - ABWE - Durban, South Africa

The Ishlers begin by sharing about a recent wedding: "We had a wonderful opportunity in December to attend the wedding of our local vet. He lost his wife during covid and has 2 children. The new couple asked Darin to officiate the wedding. The vet is Hindu, and the bride is Catholic. They asked Darin to preach in front of their family and friends for 30 minutes about the love of God. Darin was very nervous knowing he could not share about God's love without talking about Jesus. He did a wonderful job sharing the Gospel, planting a seed in the hearts of many who were there. Ella was able to be with her family for Christmas. While there she was a counselor at youth camp. "The time went fast, but we enjoyed every minute with her!" Benevolence - "Part of sharing the Gospel is sharing the love of Jesus. Giving Christmas dinners to those in need is a highlight for us!" The Ishlers praises are: 1) New potential teammates arrive in February for a survey trip; 2) 5 kids were saved at senior youth camp. Prayer requests are: 1) For Kathy as she counsels an unsaved youth; 2) Lexi's senior year of high school.

Hoagland, Ed & Annita - BBF - Mexico City, Mexico

Ed begins with this story: "Annita and I had the opportunity to be with and take care of 4 of our grandchildren for a few days in North Carolina. I had to head back last Saturday and preach in Mexico City, and on the flight, as I was reviewing my notes, the lady next to me was reading them also. She made a comment that she really liked what she read, and that was my chance to share the gospel with Fernando & Virginia, both of whom called on Jesus to be their personal Savior." Mexico City has become one of many places where migrants are staying in tents on the streets, unsure if they should go back to their homeland or keep trying to enter the USA. By car, the Hoaglands are 13 hours from the nearest US border. Two weeks ago the Manana From Heaven team served 105 plates of food to these migrants, preached the gospel and saw 30 salvation decisions. At another migrant camp, set up on a city street, they served 122 plates of food, preached the gospel and saw another 27 call on Jesus to be saved. Last week at another migrant camp, 149 plates of food were served, the gospel was preached and they saw another 22 people saved. "We will continue to explain the gospel to more and more people as God opens the doors for us. All of this is possible because of the special offerings we have received and because of our teams of volunteers that love God and love others. God Bless."

Timblin, Paul & Laurel - UIM - Arizona

The Timblins welcome Simeon K as their newest pilot to join UIM Aviation. Simeon & Naomi have 2 children with a 3rd due to arrive in April. They will be moving to Mexico to join the team in Tepic. Paul & Laurel ask that we pray for Simeon & Naomi and their family. This is a huge move, especially with a baby on the way that will be delivered in Mexico! Recently a crack was found in an Outboard landing gear casting. This is a big deal and a good thing to find. "When I see something like this, I am amazed and so thankful for the maintenance skill of Paul and our other guys in the shop. I know our families in Mexico who have Dad/Hubby flying these planes are thankful too. Thank you for praying for our guys to have sharp eyes and wisdom as they inspect the planes looking for itty bitty things that can create great big issues if not addressed." Paul began his travels for 2025 with a trip to TX for the Pilot Meetings. This is a week of strategizing, evaluation and fellowship for our pilots. Your prayers for safety in using the airplanes to reach people in the mountains of Mexico for Christ are appreciated.

Rizzo, Tony & Becky - Youth Action Ministries - Morton, PA

In this update, Tony & Becky share more about themselves so their supporters can know them better. They also share about the various YAM programs:

Evangelism 4 Today where Dr. Tony Rizzo shares Christian motivational videos, street preaching content, encouragement in God's grace, and more to help you grow as a believer through the power of the Holy Spirit and learning the Word of God as you serve Jesus.

Youth Ministry Newsletter channel that teaches all things about youth ministry. Dr. Tony Rizzo has been leading cutting-edge youth ministries nationwide for 45 years.

Youthfluential: Digital Safety Zones have made effective outreach and inroads in ministering the gospel to many students & families searching for truth. It is a great privilege to be used in this ministry. Here are some remarkable statistics from their journey: In the past 5 years, they have reached 5 million views across all their media platforms and built a community 10,000 followers across their platforms. This outreach is a testament to the impact of consistent, effective ministry. "We humbly ask for your continued prayers as we balance our digital outreach with Safety Zones Ministry."

Kids Safety Zones seeks to bless churches that want to reach students with the gospel. The gospel message is brought to children and families nationwide through Tony's Tales Conferences.

Strayer, Hannah - ABWE - Togo, Africa

Hannah shares the story of a VOL student, Elie (Elijah in English). When Beky, VOL's current assistant director asks Elie how she can pray for him, he almost always asks for prayer for his mother. About 2 years ago, Elie's mother became paralyzed after giving birth to a baby who died soon after. For a year, she was unable to get out of bed. Thankfully, now she can walk again, but the trauma has left its mark. Elie's dad left during this time, and they have heard that he has several other "wives" with many children to support. On a visit to see Elie, they found only his mother at home. After asking some questions about her salvation and hearing her answers, they were not sure she clearly understood the Gospel though she mentioned often how God helped her walk again and saved her life. They were able to "share with her that there is someone who loves her unconditionally and will always love her; tears flowed down her cheeks." God gave Beky the words "your son really loves you—whenever I ask him how I can pray for him, he always says to pray for you. She cried more." They prayed together and when they "asked for permission to leave she said, "I want to confess Jesus." The Gospel was explained to her again and they trust she understood and is now a child of God in need of encouragement and community. "Please keep Elie and his mother and their family in your prayers!"

Rardin, Clint & Rhonda - Mexico City, Mexico

The Rardins begin with "God blessed our Christmas Sunday with a well-done Christmas play and another full auditorium. Two adults walked the aisle and were saved." Christmas Eve Clint received a call from a family who received an invitation to the Christmas play and needed transportation and they came on the new bus route. "God is blessing this new bus route. They had eleven riders the other Sunday. We have consistently seen several adults attending." The church in Naucalpan now has a very nice baptistry in the church. It was used for the first time several weeks ago when they baptized a married couple. On another Sunday, Pastor Oscar baptized a lady who was saved in our VBS last summer. "God is so good! Thank you for your prayers for that ministry." Their letter ends with "Thank you for your faithful support and all your prayers for our family and ministry."

Serino, Nick & Darianne - North Slope Baptist Mission - Point Hope, Alaska

"With the start of the New Year we have seen some folks getting back to church after being absent for a long time. It is a blessing to see them get back into the things of God and hearing the Word of God." The Serinos see that all services are returning to normal following the holidays and that both Sunday School and Teen Class are growing. "We really need everyone to pray for a missionary family to answer the call to take over the ministry in Wainwright. Bro. Henry & family will be heading back to Anchorage after years of filling in to keep this ministry going. "We started this work in 1983 and it would be a shame to have to leave it without a pastor after all that God has done there over the years!" The Serinos thank you all so much for your prayers and sacrifice for Arctic Missions and for them.

Lennon, John & Ronda - Daystar Baptist Missions - Ecuador

The Lennons share the story of "Stephen (not his real name), a Persian pastor in the Middle East. He is the son of an Ayatollah, a high-ranking cleric in the Shia Muslim world. Before becoming a Christian, Stephen lived a disorderly life, enjoying the pleasures of the world. After trusting Jesus Christ as his Savior, Stephen was excommunicated from his family, beaten and left to die on the side of the street. Realizing that only Jesus can fill the emptiness in his heart, he went to live in another country and felt called to preach, where he pastors a small Baptist church. Pastor Stephen invited John and a missionary friend to travel to the Middle East to give a seminar to a group of church leaders from the underground church of Iran. As the group crossed the border from Iran into another country, they all received phone calls that the Iranian government had raided every one of their homes, arrested family members and relatives, and confiscated all their Bibles and Christian literature. The government threatened to kidnap Pastor Stephen's wife and child if he continued to preach the Gospel. That was how we started the weeklong leadership seminar. As the week went on, news of more raids, arrests, and even the execution of a pastor was received with great sadness. Yet, in the midst of all of the disturbing reports, a spontaneous prayer meeting took place late at night around a campfire, singing and praising God for His faithfulness and goodness. Words cannot describe those moments, witnessing these brothers and sisters give glory to God even though they knew that they may never be able to return to their homes. Persecution is never a pleasant thing to go through, but it is what God uses to purify and grow His church. In our last letter, we mentioned about the threats that we had received and that we had to remove ourselves from Ecuador for our safety. After several months of investigation, we have found that those threats remain intact. So, we will continue to work remotely for the time being."
