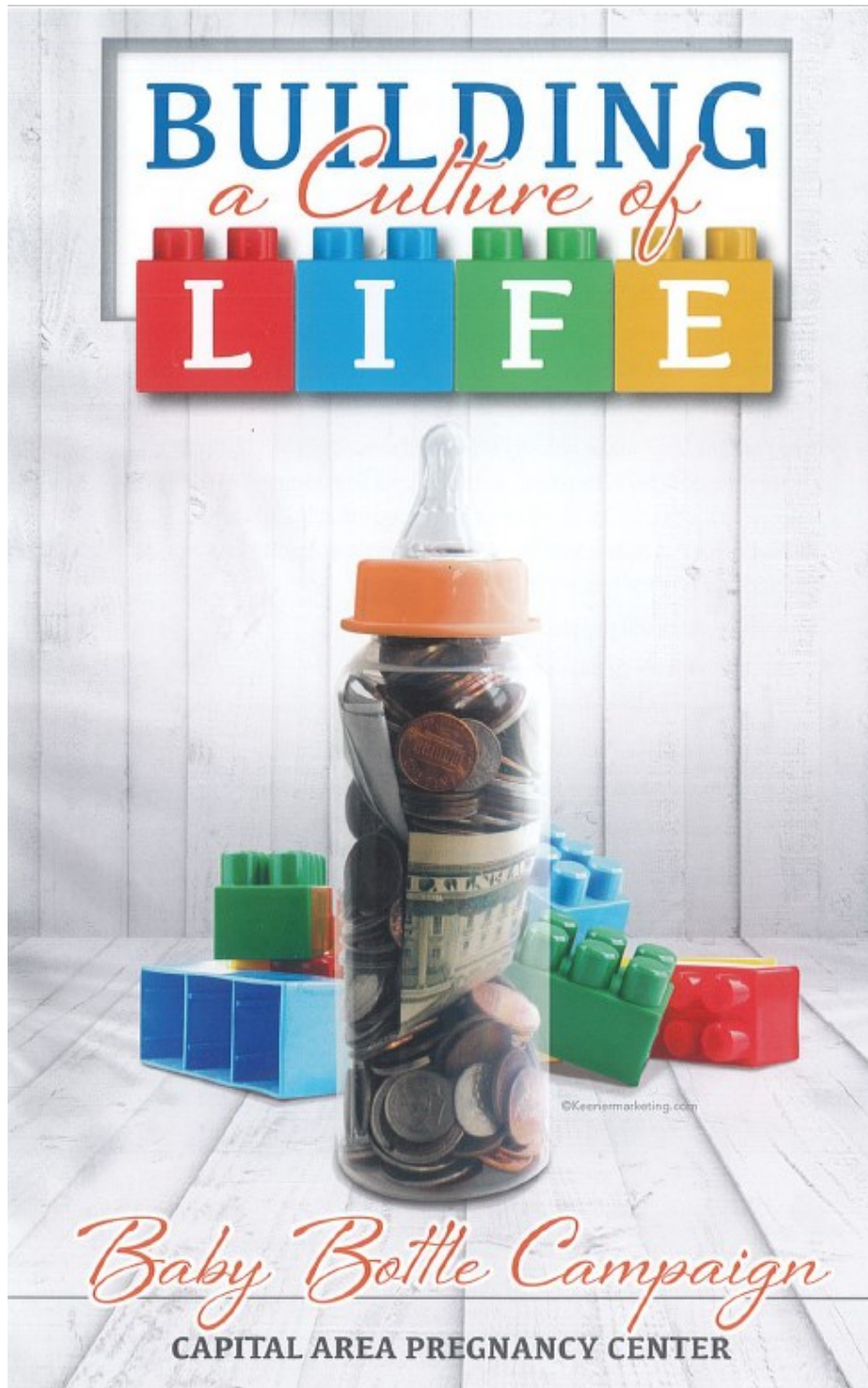

EIGHT OUTSTANDING QUALITIES OF A GOOD WOMAN

Proverbs 31:10-31, NLT

The quickest way for a mother to get her children's attention is to sit down and look comfortable.

A mother's patience is like a tube of toothpaste - it's never quite all gone.

"I don't think there are enough devils in hell to take a young person from the arms of a godly mother." ~ Billy Sunday

- ◆ She Is Trusted By Her Husband - ¹⁰ Who can find a virtuous and capable wife? She is more precious than rubies. ¹¹ Her husband can trust her, and she will greatly enrich his life. ¹² She brings him good, not harm, all the days of her life. (vs 10-12)
 - ◇ She is Virtuous - noble, strong, capable, valiant
 - ◇ She is Valuable - her husband harbors no doubts, suspicions or questions
 - ◇ She is Outstanding - her commitment to her husband is true not false, constant not temperamental, reliable, not fickle

- ◆ She Is A Hard Worker - ¹³ She finds wool and flax and busily spins it. ¹⁴ She is like a merchant's ship, bringing her food from afar. ¹⁵ She gets up before dawn to prepare breakfast for her household and plan the day's work for her servant girls. ¹⁶ She goes to inspect a field and buys it; with her earnings she plants a vineyard. ¹⁷ She is energetic and strong, a hard worker. ¹⁸ She makes sure her dealings are profitable; her lamp burns late into the night. ¹⁹ Her hands are busy spinning thread, her fingers twisting fiber. (vs 13-19)
 - ◇ She uses her head
 - ◇ She uses her heart
 - ◇ She uses her hands
 - ◇ She uses her habits

- ◆ She Is Compassionate - She extends a helping hand to the poor and opens her arms to the needy. (vs 20)
 - ◇ She is ready to help the poor
 - ◇ She is ready to help the needy

- ◆ She Is Ready For Tough Times - ²¹ She has no fear of winter for her household, for everyone has warm clothes. ²² She makes her own bedspreads. She dresses in fine linen and purple gowns. (vs 21-22)
 - ◇ She takes care of her family
 - ◇ She takes care of herself

- ◆ She Is A Blessing To Her Husband - ²³ Her husband is well known at the city gates, where he sits with the other civic leaders. (vs 23)
 - ◇ She enhances his reputation
 - ◇ She extends his responsibilities

- ◆ She Is Endowed With Godly Wisdom - ²⁴ She makes belted linen garments and sashes to sell to the merchants. ²⁵ She is clothed with strength and dignity, and she laughs without fear of the future. ²⁶ When she speaks, her words are wise, and she gives instructions with kindness. ²⁷ She carefully watches everything in her household and suffers nothing from laziness. (vs 24-27)
 - ◇ She is active with her hands
 - ◇ She is adorned by her character
 - ◇ She is appropriate in her speech
 - ◇ She is attentive in her home

- ◆ She Is Admired By Her Family - ²⁸ Her children stand and bless her. Her husband praises her: ²⁹ "There are many virtuous and capable women in the world, but you surpass them all!" (vs 28-29)
 - ◇ Her children bless her
 - ◇ Her husband praises her

- ◆ She Is Honored By Her Lord - ³⁰ Charm is deceptive, and beauty does not last; but a woman who fears the LORD will be greatly praised. ³¹ Reward her for all she has done. Let her deeds publicly declare her praise. (vs 30-31)
 - ◇ She has godly priorities
 - ◇ She has a godly perspective
 - ◇ She receives godly praise

Personal Reflection and Practical Application

- ⇒ Why do you think motherhood is such a disputed topic today in Western Culture?
- ⇒ How can women, wives and mothers guard against being crushed by the ideal woman?
- ⇒ If you are a woman, wife and/or mother, which qualities from this passage are most challenging?
- ⇒ If you are a woman, wife and/or mother, where do you see the grace of God forming you into the character of this excellent woman?
- ⇒ How does the gospel of Jesus Christ empower us to live faithfully in the roles to which God has called us?
- ⇒ A little boy who was told by his mother that it was God who made people good, responded "Yes, I know that it is God, but Mothers help a lot!"
