FAITH PROMISE MISSIONARY UPDATES

Parschauer Sr, Bob & Mary Anne - WOL European Representative

The Parschauers are on a 6-week WOL mission tour. Their tour schedule is packed with visits to Germany, Czech Republic, Kenya, Poland, Hungary, Austria, and more. The updates they have been sending from this tour are extensive, so only a few highlights are included in this update. The two days prior to fly to Munich, Germany they attended the WOL Directors Conference in FL. At the conference, they were able to meet with directors from 87 countries. Serbia is one of the countries highlighted from the conference. You "can drive 50 miles and not find an evangelical church." They are in need of scholarships for children to attend summer camp along with support the Novaks who serve with WOL in Serbia. Their current support level is only 50%. "E5M stands for Eternity 5 Million. During the month of March, 2025, WOL set a goal to share the Gospel with 5 million people around the world in 30 days. Just think... The total number of people was 6,805,431 and the numbers are still coming in. ... Praise the Lord that during those 30 days, 72,866 young people professed faith in Jesus and 31,261 dedicated their lives to a closer walk and service for Him! WOW!" Last summer the Parschauers traveled with the Tim Good family to raise funds for a new gymnasium at the English 4 Life school. On this trip they were blessed to see the progress of the construction. Johnny was saved when Bob preached at snow camp 5 years ago. He just completed high school and expressed to Bob how God is working in his life and he has a growing desire to attend WOL Bible Institute in Hungary. "Would you pray for this young man?" "Lots going on in Czechia...construction, camp prepara-tions, English classes, school, and lots more." They ask that we pray for the construction to be completed in time for summer camps. Bob has a long-time involvement with Hungary, going back 15 yrs prior to WOL's involvement there. "In the mid-1980's a thawing of relations between East & West resulted in Bob being able to hold the first-ever Christian you camp in a communist country." Pray for the Parschauers continue to have safe travels and the stamina needed for this tour.

Lorow, Ken & Eileen - ABWE Director of Prefield Ministries

Ken shared about personal reflection and gratitude during Memorial Day. Over 30 yrs ago, Ken lost his father in a car accident after serving 18 yrs in the military. "He was a man of deep love for his country, his family, and the Lord. His example shaped so much of who I am today and continues to inspire me in both life and ministry. ... Thank you, as always, for your faithful partnership. Your prayers and support allow me to continue a different kind of service: sharing the hope of Christ in a world that desperately needs Him. I believe my father would be proud - not just of me, but each of you who link arms in this mission." The Lorows recently placed an offer on a home that was for sale, but another offer was accepted. "We accepted that as God's clear direction to stay put. But God had other plans." The other buyer backed out and rather than relisting, the owner called Ken & Eileen wanting to accept their offer. "We're humbled and amazed by how God orchestrated this." They ask that we pray for the following: 1) That their current home sells quickly and above asking price; 2) They need to sell their current home by July 31st which is the closing date for their new home; and 3) Preparations to list their home. "Please pray for energy, clarity, and that all the details come together smoothly."

Hoagland, Ed & Annita - BBF in Mexico City

"God is doing some BIG things in Mexico and in the world. It's a privilege to participate with Him and observe His great power and love for the souls of all human beings. I definitely don't want for this marvelous movement and moment to end." On a Saturday, 22 people in 3 cars traveled 2-1/2 hrs to a town of 9,000. 71 people showed up with 32 salvation decisions. Later that day in a small town of 170 inhabitants, 61 people showed up with 21 salvation decisions. And that same day, their evangelistic team visited a hospital and won another 4 souls for Christ. "These are beautiful and blessed days to be actively serving our Lord. Thank you so much for your prayers and support for this ministry. Ed & Annita ask that we pray as they "seek to motivate and convince more churches to help us fill up more buses to take to our summer evangelistic youth camps. Our goal is to take 4,500 unbelievers, but we still need to get people to begin working on filling up and taking 52 buses."

Serino, Nick & Darianne - North Slope Baptist Missions in the Alaskan Arctic

God's blessings and answered prayers provided for a successful spring whaling season. With the season over, folks are returning back to church. They recently had a 4-day meeting to celebrate the 30th anniversary of Tikigaq Bible Baptist Church in Point Hope. "As always we thank Almighty God for you all! Your Prayers and sacrificial giving have allowed the victories and projects to go on in the Arctic villages up here for over 42 yrs now! New challenges face us as both Wainwright and Point Lay will be without preaches soon this year! Please keep these ministries before the Lord in asking Him to provide families to take over these works for His glory; and to see precious souls rescued from sin, death and hell through our Great Saviour!"

Rardin, Clint & Rhonda - Mexico City

The Rardins begin with "On May 2nd, we had the blessing of seeing our last child, Elias, graduate from Fairhaven Baptist College. What a joy to see our children walking in truth!" God has done a work that the Rardins never expected. Many families (mostly military) have been attending the last 4 months. "We have had incredible Sunday services with extra metal chairs put down even into the hallway outside the auditorium doors. We even had to use our lobby bench when we ran out of chairs." All the new families have replaced the 50 adults and half of the children that left to attend the new church they started in October. The new bus route has grown from 3 or 4 adults to an average of 16 adults with high days of 25 during the spring campaign. During the campaign, 5 our of 6 Sundays saw multiple people saved. The Friday addictions program has grown to as many as 38 with new people attending every Friday except 1 since January. "Please pray as we seriously think about looking for a bigger place. I was thinking we had another 2 or 3 yrs, but we may need to move before the end of the year. We are truly thankful for your prayers and financial support and know that these spiritual blessings are due to your faithful intercession for us and our ministry."

Hawes, Tim & Leandra - ABWE in Papua New Guinea

"The training trip to Manus Island ended wonderfully, but started with a coldness we never faced before. After much prayer, God gave us the breakthrough in our teaching on the 3rd day. To our great joy we also discovered one of our GBBC graduates had already been leading a Bible Club in the public school close to his church." Tim asks for prayer for his mother. She was diagnosed with cancer and had a successful surgery the end of February. She is currently undergoing chemo. They greatly appreciate their sending church being there for Tim's family since they are so far away. "Please pray for the Lord's healing and limited side effects from chemo. The Hawes praise God that the Education Dept. has received their curriculum and is reviewing it. The goal is for it to be an official resource book for public schools. "These processes can drag out and we need God's blessing for a speedy, favorable answer." They end with "Once again, we ask you when you come to a school crossing to slow down and pray for the Bible Clubs that God would send true revival."

Beard, Sam & Megan - BBFI on Jeju Island, South Korea

Nations Baptist Church celebrated 6 yrs of Sunday services this past Easter. Outside of the missionary team, only 1 family from the original group still lives on Jeju Island. The church exists to engage the international community living on Jeju, so the congregation is made up of people who are temporary residents. Every summer the Beards enter a season of transition, saying "See you later!" to friends and church members. They have sent off 5 families and 3 single adults in June. This month they welcomed 6 people as members of their church through believer's baptism; 4 are leaving Jeju this summer to move on to other countries. "They are leaving Nations Baptist Church closer to Jesus than when they arrived, and they are taking the gospel with them!" The Beards ask that we pray with them through this transition: 1) Those that were sent quickly find a church in their new location; 2) Those who remain will not lose heart as they "stay behind"; and 3) That they will hospitably welcome newcomers to their community who need to experience the grace and truth of Jesus.

Rizzo, Dr. Tony & Becky - Youth Action Ministries, Morton, PA

The Kensington Street Outreach was truly wonderful to witness. Numerous individuals were counseled and heard the gospel message. "It was amazing to see our team members step out in faith, having powerful opportunities to witness to those walking the streets of Kensington. God's love was tangibly felt throughout the community. The Youth Safety Zone exceeded expectations! "Over 50 students came out to hear the gospel message, and their attention was remarkable - they listened intently as the good news was shared." Several dozen students responded to the invitation to receive Christ. Their update ends with "Your partnership through prayer and support makes all of this possible. Thank you for standing with us in reaching our community with the hope of Christ!"

Strayer, Hannah - ABWE in Togo

Hannah shares 'Recently I was in a conversation with a family preparing to leave Togo after a 9 month stay here. We began to talk about the concept of home. I truly believe that missionaries have a deeper understanding than most of what it means to know that this world is not our "home".' Hannah then shares a story about home. There is no way to include the story in this limited amount of space, but you can read it on the missionary wall in the hallway outside of the chapel. Hannah's praises: 1) Safe travels and a successful project; 2) A good end to the school year in Togo; and 3) For all that is done for His glory around the world. She asks that we pray for projects on the docket to try and get done before leaving Togo in August.
