Light refreshments will be served in the rear of the Chapel each night.



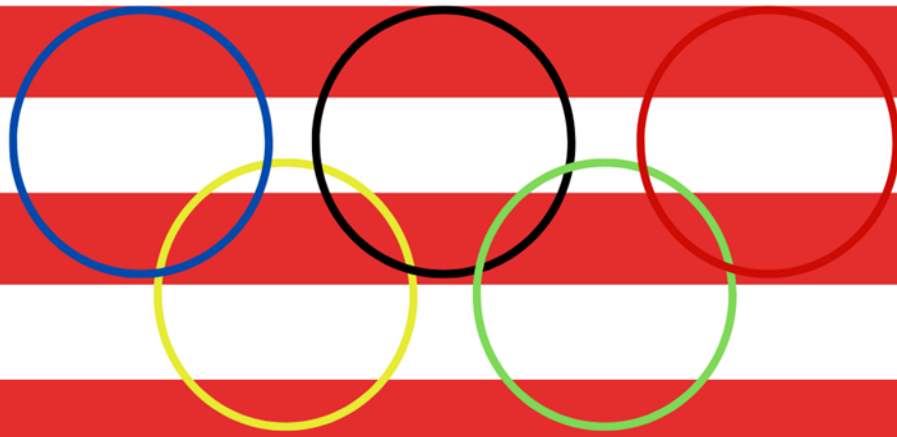

- A Bible Memory program that benefits the children, families, schools, local churches and the community.
- A legal program that is protected by Federal and State Laws.
- A privately funded community effort of interested, committed Christians volunteering their time to reach boys and girls with the Word of God.

- More than half of these children are unchurched.

Two hours of weekly commitment which includes:

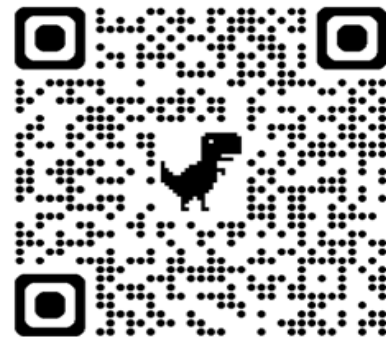
- ◇ A Bible lesson time.

THE BLESSING OF THE GIFT OF AFFIRMATION!

Affirmation is a statement that something is true.

To show approval, encouragement and support.

A "Free-Handed" gift of recognizing God's work in someone's life.

- **God the Father Affirms His People!**

¹⁶ For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. *John 3:16, NKJV*

- **God the Son Affirms People!**

14 "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. ² In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. *John 14:1-3, NKJV*

- **God the Holy Spirit Affirms People!**

¹⁶ And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever— *John 14:16, NKJV*

¹⁸ I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you. *John 14:18, NKJV*

²⁵ "These things I have spoken to you while being present with you. ²⁶ But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you. ²⁷ Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. *John 14:25-27, NKJV*

- **God's Word Affirms People!**

⁷ Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go. ⁸ This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. ⁹ Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God *is* with you wherever you go.”
Joshua 1:7-9, NKJV

- **God's People Affirm People!**

⁹ Let love *be* without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good. ¹⁰ Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another; ¹¹ not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; ¹² rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer; ¹³ distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.

¹⁴ Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. ¹⁵ Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep. ¹⁶ Be of the same mind toward one another. Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion. *Romans 12:9-16, NKJV*
