FAITH PROMISE MISSIONARY UPDATES

Custodio, Maicon & Leticia - WOL Spain

The Custodios have been very busy with various projects: Summer camps, church retreat in Barcelona, Join the Cause evangelism, women's meetings, Olympians from the 23/24 school term, staff retreat, ministry in Europe at WOL United Kingdom, and family. Their love for the Lord is evident throughout their update, especially in their praises and prayer requests. Praises are: 1) For the end of SARAH and ANNA's school year, 2) for the opportunity to SERVE the Word Of Life UK missionaries, 3) For the PART-NERSHIP with LIFESHAPE (staff retreat), 4) For the blessing of our STAFF RETREAT, and 5) For the DE-LIVERANCE of our parents, brothers and nephews in the floods in South Brazil. Prayer requests are: 1) For wisdom and discernment in all circumstances and decisions throughout our MINITERIAL YEAR, 2) For the opportunities to SHARE THE WORD OF GOD at the Summer Camps, 3) For Maicon's STUDIES, so that God may give him the strength and discipline to continue in the midst of the summer camps, 4) For the preparations for the SUMMER CAMPS, 5) For the EVANGELISM TRAINING that Maicon will receive in July. May this training be a powerful tool in the EXPANSION of the gospel in Spain, 6) For the provision for Summer Camp Scholarships, and 7) For PROTECTION, PHYSICAL and SPIRITUAL HEALTH of the FAMILY, especially for our CHILDREN. <u>7/19/24 Update:</u> The first week of the 2024 Summer Camp Season is finished and they are about to finish the 2nd week. Dozens of transformational decisions have been made which encourages and recharges the Custodios. Last week, "with other leaders from 5 continents, Maicon attended an International Conference in the area of evangelism. The challenge is, together with these global leaders, to promote the gospel among the youth in Spain and Europe. Pray for wisdom to activate our youth, serve the churches and reach our generation with the gospel of Jesus Christ.'

Hoagland, Ed & Annita - Mexico City, Mexico

On Saturday, June 15th, 17 people from their main congregation went to a migrant camp with over 170 people, mainly from Central and South America. "We gave them food, drink, clothes and the gospel of Jesus Christ. Thankful to say that all heard the Good news and 52 made a profession of faith in Jesus Christ." At the End of Year program for their Christian school, over 180 family members arrived. The parents are very excited and happy with the development of their children. Ed & Annita ask that we pray for them to enroll more 4 & 5 yr olds, 1st thru 3rd and 6th graders for the new year which begins August 12th. They have all the needed teachers, now they need to fill each class with 12 students. There are many events scheduled all of July and August, although another \$2,750 was needed to reach their goal. On June 19th, Ed received a call that the remaining \$2,550 needed for the evangelistic events was covered by a friend. "We praise God once again for His provision to help us reach more Mexicans with the message of the Messiah." The same day, a second call opened the door to reach more young people. The Rawlings Foundation contacted the Hoaglands to do camps again. "They asked us to take 3,000 unbelieving young people to hear the Good News." Please pray that they can get everything organized in a short period of time and they can get 40 churches to have the vision and energy to become involved. "Our simple theme will be Metanoia (repentance). It might not be as well done as in the past years because of lack of funds and time, but we will do our best to see more young people hear the gospel, get saved, baptized, discipled (something that will happen through the follow-up) and enroll in Bible College. That was all something that Dr. John Rawlings always told me we had to do at his camp."

Lorow, Ken & Eileen - ABWE Director of Prefield Ministries

Ken and Eileen begin by sharing about their visits with ABWE missionaries in Africa. (Some of the photos from their trip include NLC's Ishler family and Hannah Strayer.) "We enjoyed a memorable South African Braai with our team, sharing stories and enjoying the time together. It was a perfect opportunity to bond and reflect on our shared desire to make Christ known. It's also been heartwarming to discover that some of our national partners were taught by some of the same professors we had at Baptist Bible College/Clark Summit University. It's incredible to see the lasting impact these professors have had, not only over the decades but globally." Ken & Eileen were able to attend the regional conference with the East Africa team. "It's been inspiring to witness firsthand the impactful ministries taking place and to see God's work unfolding in beautiful ways. Throughout our time here, we've been blessed to encourage and support the missionaries we've met. We've had the opportunities to participate in their ministries and explore the stunning landscapes of this country they call home." Ken and Eileen are now home. With their change in responsibility to Director of Prefield Ministries, they are involved in various levels of training. Their role is to support missionaries as they navigate these training sessions, providing guidance and encouragement helping them prepare for their upcoming ministries. During the next 3 weeks (July 15th, 22nd & 29th) they are busy with 50 missionary units for various training sessions, including missionary orientation, essential mission components, and departure readiness. [While Ken & Eileen are in training with these missionaries, the MK's (missionary kids) are here at NLC for their training with the MK team to help them be prepared for life as a MK.] They end their update with "Please pray for us as we minister to these individuals during this crucial time in their journey. Your prayers are invaluable as we strive to support and equip them."

Bennett, Dan & Becky - Sao Paulo, Brazil

'We want to say a big "THANK YOU" to those of you that have been praying for the requests that we mentioned in our last prayer letter.' There was a men's cookout at the home of one of the deaf men from the church in Aruja. Emerson was the only deaf visiting man that showed up. Luciano had invited Emerson to the cookout and to come to church. Emerson said he couldn't come to church because he was going to another church to see a baby get "baptized". Luciano asked Emerson if he knew the meaning of baptizing a baby. He did not. This opened the door for Luciano to begin witnessing to Emerson. After a few minutes, Luciano asked Dan to assist. Dan began to simply explain the Gospel message to Emerson. Another man got a small "Wordless Book" and Dan began explaining the meaning of the colors. '...it was if a "light came on" in Emerson's heart and mind." After nearly 45 minutes, Emerson bowed his head and asked the Lord to forgive him for his sin and save him! Praise the Lord!" Becky began teaching "The Wordless Book" after church services. There are several children in the class. Some of the deaf adults stand around to watch the lessons. Two children recently trusted Christ as Savior from this class. Gustavo, a deaf boy, made a video of what he has learned so far, and he is so excited about the things that "Mrs. Rebecca" is teaching. Gustavo is not yet saved, but we believe that it won't be long. The Bennets ask that we pray for Gustavo's salvation. They also ask for prayers for God to send two men (and their families) to become pastors for two deaf churches. "One young Brazilian pastor visited the church in Aruja ... he is praying about God's will about becoming the pastor... Your fervent prayers would be greatly appreciated!"

Rizzo, Tony & Becky - Youth Action Ministries

"Praise the Lord! We have seen remarkable things in our Tony's Tales Conferences/Kids Safety Zones." In June, Becky & Tony finished a week-long conference with youth in Chichester, PA. Tony shared his messages on the paint board and gospel illustrations each night. The students continued to come out each night and brought their friends as the week went on. Many of the students came from broken homes and showed the effects of living in homes with intense hardships. Becky ministered to the students daily, and they had an excellent connection with her. "Many trusted in the Lord as their Savior and other decisions were made during the week of meetings." Becky is healing and showing signs of full recovery. She gradually shows physical improvement in her lungs each week. The chronic illness of Lupus is still very active in her system. We are now resting in the Lord and will continue seeking guidance from the medical community. 'We're beyond excited to announce our brand-new membership program, "Champions for Christ!" 100% of the donations go to providing and preparing Safety Zones. Safety Zones are our primary mission to share the Gospel with young people in the inner city. We spend many days promoting and preparing for the events, gathering supplies, food, and volunteers to help. E go to the schools and local communities to connect with the young people and invite them out. We share food, games, and the Gospel in a safe and engaging environment during the events. The young people hear the Good news of Jesus Christ and are connected with local churches to continue growing and knowing about the Lord. Join us on this amazing journey to make a difference! Whether you donate once or commit to our program monthly, every bit helps, and together, we can continue to share the Gospel!"

Strayer, Hannah - ABWE - Togo Hannah's update focuses on Sound Doctrine Fellowship church and radio station Vuma FM103 in Durban, South Africa. "The men and women we spoke to had similar stories about coming to Sound Doctrine Fellowship. They were dissatisfied with what they were learning in their current church, it was confusing. One way or another, they found Vuma FM and began to understand that the teaching they heard on this radio station was truth! And they began to attend the church mentioned at the end of the program. Pastor Dennis Nkosi has been on Vuma FM for several years now, and the Zulu broadcast has grown from about 100 listeners to around 250,000! The people of Durban and even surrounding cities are hungry for the truth of Scripture, for sound teaching, and are eager to find a place of worship that teaches this truth...His on-air partner, Pastor Pakhamani Khoza has seen his church grow by about 50% thanks to Vuma & SDF—which was planted by men who began in the Bible training program after listening to Vuma—has seen 99-100% of their growth as a result of the radio program! In fact, one man told me that at SDF they don't invite people to their church but instead refer them to listen to Vuma to hear for themselves. Many of those people then end up at SDF for regular worship and ministry. God is doing HUGE things through this program, but it is quite costly to operate. Prayer requests: 1) Hannah has 2 more weeks in South Africa before returning to Togo, 2) For Vuma FM to continue on-air, and 3) Storytellers Abroad planning for Tanzania in Sept & possible trip to Zambia.

Serino, Nick & Darianne - The Alaskan Arctic

The Serinos wrote their update from Phoenix, AZ and begin with "Well thanks to your effectual and fervent prayers, the transplant procedure was completed yesterday, the 5th! All went perfect, with no complications or reactions as of right now! However, I have no immune system until the cells start doing their job grafting in with the bone marrow or something like that. Everything so far has been done outpatient, but any glitch and into the hospital I go. Please pray for no infections or fever, they say reactions from the heavy chemo will start showing up any day now." The Serinos plan on being back in Fairbanks the first week in August, but "the doctor says to stay in Fairbanks another month of so before getting back to the village. All depends on the cells engrafting and doing their job increasing my immune system." Nick & Darianne celebrated their 51st Anniversay on July 7th! "Can't do much to celebrate it but God has been so good to me giving me such a godly wife to share the joys and heartbreaks of our 42 years of ministry! I cannot end this letter without saying a BIG THANK YOU for all the praying and special offerings to help with travel and expenses from you all! Our Almighty God—through you folks has made this episode in life so much easier to be we are so VERY GRATEFUL for you all! Also, please keep in prayer all the North Slope Churches in Barrow, Wainwright, Pt. Lay and Pt. Hope! There is a constant need for High Arctic Missionaries, but the laborers are few."

Ivey, Mike & Jill - Korea

The Iveys begin their update with the Nations Shin Jeju startup. Since Easter, more than 50 people from 8 nations have attended service in the new location, primarily from Asian countries. WIN (World Initiative Network) missionaries, Mike & Melanie Shaw, are taking the key role in leading the weekly meetings; newly approved WIN missionaries, Mark & Faith Guzman, are busy raising their support to serve in the near future. "There is a deep and abiding joy in seeing people who have been taught, led to Christ, baptized, and trained, then sent on their way to their next work opportunity to be witnesses for Christ. Not only do the people we reach through this ministry come from multiple nations, but they also go out to multiple nations. ELEVEN family permanently left Jeju in June. Some are going to North America, but others are headed to far away Guatemala, India, Morocco, Lithuania, and Saudi Arabia! Pray for new missionaries, the Shaws & Guzmans, and pray for the Iveys as well. Specifically, ask God for His power and leading as they continue to reach people.

Lennon, John & Ronda - Ecuador

The Lennons share the story of a professional athlete from Iran who won multiple medals at the World Championships and Asian Games. He was also a writer, editor, poet, and published several books and articles. One day, someone shared the Gospel with him in Tehran and he trusted Jesus Christ as his Savior. Upon sharing his faith through his writings and in person, he had to flee Iran due to the oppressive persecution that he started receiving. Fast forward in the story: The Lennons were introduced to this man when they were searching for someone to translate discipleship materials in the Farsi language. After completion, he then agreed to organize a translation team to translate the children's Bible curriculum "99 Adventures in the Bible's Big Story" by Dr. Jim Cook. The project is close to 70% complete. An educator in Tehran trusted Jesus Christ as their Savior while translating the part of Jesus' substitutional death on the cross. "Even with the difficulties in living in Iran, God continues to bring people to Himself because of your desire to see people saved. Please pray for the translation team as they work diligently to finish the last sections of the curriculum and for the salvation of the Farsi speaking children who will hear God's Word, many for the first time."

<u>Litson, Matt & Sarah - New Brunswick, French Canada</u>




The Special Summer Sunday Nights at NLC will be held in the Chapel from 5:30 -7 pm.
