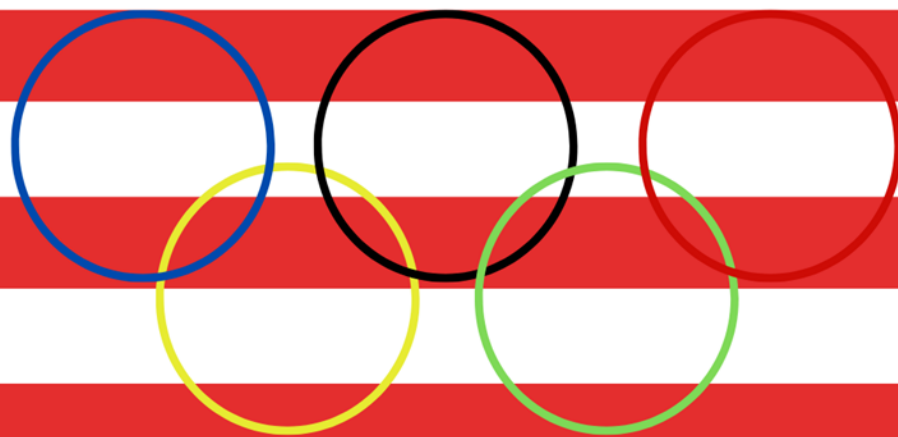

- A Bible Memory program that benefits the children, families, schools, local churches and the community.
- A legal program that is protected by Federal and State Laws.
- A privately funded community effort of interested, committed Christians volunteering their time to reach boys and girls with the Word of God.

- Over 3,300 students in grades 3 through 9 in 28 school districts are involved.
- More than half of these children are unchurched.
- It takes over 1,200 volunteers for Bible Adventure to work.

VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED

Volunteers:

- ♦ Be blessed as you use your gifts to impact a child's life.
- ♦ Grow spiritually in a smaller community where you will find a sense of belonging.
- ♦ Impact the next generation by helping students learn about God.
- ♦ Help students memorize and understand God's Word.
- ♦ Experience God at work as you lead children into a relationship with Jesus.

Bible Adventure Involves...

Two hours of weekly commitment which includes:

- ♦ A Bible lesson time.
- ♦ A listening time for individual attention to children when adults can model godly living.
- ♦ A prayer time that implants Biblical principles.

Volunteers are needed to serve as:

- ♦ **Teacher:** teaches a 15-minute Bible lesson.
- ♦ **Listener:** helps to encourage and listens to verses; develops a close, personal relationship with students.
- ♦ **Prayer Warrior:** prays regularly for the ministry of Bible Adventure.
