FAITH PROMISE MISSIONARY UPDATES

Parschauer, Bob & Mary Anne - WOL European Representative

The Parschauers are now at home in Canada resting up from their 6-week tour of Europe and Kenya. The following are some highlights of their time in Nairobi & Mombasa, Kenya. Kenya is in East Africa, bordering the Indian Ocean. The country is the size of Texas. The country has a young population, with 73% of 47,564,296 residents being under the age of 30. "According to google, there are approximately 2.5 million slum dwellers in about 200 settlements in Nairobi, representing 60% of Nairobi's population." That is a lot of young people living in poverty in the slums. At the "Counselors' Hangout" for the day camp workers, they met about 60 young adults. Bob filled them in on the history of WOL in Kenya. "Our hearts were especially touched to hear them sing about 'broken chains' in the song Jesus Christ, My Living Hope. At the end we all sang How Great Thou Art together. Our hearts were throbbing and our eyes were brimming. What a beautiful experience, to think this is fruit from four young Canadian prairie boys going to Germany and branching out to Kenya." Bob & Mary Anne stayed at WOL Diani Beach, near Mombasa. "In the early 1980's President Moi asked Larry Locken to build a school for the children in the area, as there wasn't one nearby. They started with 1st grade, and added another grade each year. There are now 442 students from pre-K through 8th grade. The studies are Scripture-based and there are chapels every week. Several Muslim families send their children to this school. Many have been saved because of this." For the preschoolers, seeing someone with white skin is rare. One girl just wanted to touch Mary Anne's hand while another looked at her with a questioning expression on her face. "I'm somewhat of a puzzle to her." The Parschauers were blessed with the experience of a glass bottom boat trip. They saw many of God's creations such as red starfish (they looked like plastic but eventually moved), sea anemones, long spined urchin, many zebra fish and an eel fish. They end with "There is no way for us to summarize the blessings of this whole trip - Germany, Czech Republic, Poland, Hungary, Austria, Kenya. We are more equipped to pray for and support our workers, and to share their ministries with you. Praise the Lord. Thank you for standing with us."

Custodio, Maicon & Leticia - WOL Spain & Europe

The Custodios gave an update on the E5M (Eternity 5 Million) global evangelism initiative by WOL, which aimed to share the life-changing message of Jesus Christ with 5 million people by April 2025. "E5M wasn't just a campaign, it was a call to action for every believe to take a step of faith and make a difference in the lives of those around them. The goal to be achieved was challenging. To human eyes, it seemed very difficult to achieve. ... Our aim during the month of April was to encourage Spanish churches and youth to put the Great Commission into action. As a result of this initiative, we were faced with the sad reality of the true state of the churches in the area of evangelism. ... With God's help and collaboration of all the countries where WOL is represented, 6.6 million people heard the gospel message; 68,580 people gave their lives to <u>Christ; and 29,122 dedicated their lives to Him. ... Ephesians 3:20-21."</u> They also shared that on May 10, 2025, Maicon graduated from the Master of Arts in Christian Studies program at Dallas Theological Seminary. "It took almost 5 years of a lot of reading, work and sleepless nights, but with God's grace and mercy, Maicon completed this stage." Maicon & Leticia thank everyone for praying for their daughter Sarah. Sarah completed her studies and is now in the process of preparing to attend the Bible Institute in August. Prayer requests are: 1) Economic provision for the next 2 years of Sarah's Bible Institute; 2) Sarah's success in her English test, the approval of her student visa and for the new stage of her life; 3) Maicon's next stage of studies towards his doctorate; 4) For their family, that the Lord may grant them wisdom in the education of their daughters; 5) Summer Camps and the salvation of souls; 6) Physical, emo-tional and spiritual strength; 7) Sustainment of the family and ministry so that new churches and people feel the desire to be part of it together with us; and 8) Wisdom and discernment in all circumstances and decisions throughout the Ministerial Year 2025.

Baldis, Charles & Janet - GPPD Slovakia

Their update begins with "We send greetings from our mountain ministry home in the center of Slovakia. We are thankful for the faithful support of our friends in the States to allow us to continue to invest in the lives of Europeans." They also share 'Good News' - "We are pleased to announce the coming nuptials of our daughter Tina to Jozef Licko in September. Jozo became a believer at on of our early English camps. Tina has been serving as a faithful single missionary with us for 20 years. They will make their home in Brno, Czech Republic and in Zavadka, as our Worldview teaching ministry will continue to grow outside of this country." Charles & Janet recently attended a celebration of life service in England for a dear friend. Then they went to the Czech Republic to take part in the anniversary of a church they helped to plant 30 yrs ago.

Baldis continued:

Prayer requests are: 1) Wisdom and strength as we face a full summer of ministry; 2) Tina and Jozo as they begin their journey in life together; 3) The writing of the Biblical Worldview book; 4) Funding for Emma's continued education; and 5) Funding for the continuation of the Roma (Gypsy) ministry.

Baldis, Tina - GPPD Slovakia

Dear Friends, As some of you may have heard, this year 2025 has been one of surprises and changes. My first bit of news is that I am engaged and will be getting married at the end of September. It was definitely a story written by God. I was content in my singleness and loved what God was calling me to do: teaching Biblical worldview, apologetics, English, and making disciples. That calling has not changed, rather God is starting a new chapter in my life. I have known Jozef for over 20 years, ever since he became a believer at one of our first English camps in Zavadka. We were both around 18 years old at the time. But our lives went in different directions as I went to university in the States and he went to the Czech Republic to study and stayed there for work (he works independently in the IT industry and serves as an elder in his church). I returned to Zavadka to continue the ministry, and we maintained a friendship. He would come to see us every so often when he was visiting his family who live nearby. But God changed something in both him and me, letting us know that it was the right time. We started dating in January. I knew right away though that he was the one I was going to marry. We were engaged at the beginning of May." Tina asks that we "pray for our wedding on September 27th, for we want it to be God-honoring. Jozef's and my desire is that this wedding and our marriage will truly reflect God's beautiful story and His plan for eternity: Jesus as the Groom and the Church as His bride. Pray that God will lead us how to continue to share God's love and Biblical worldview in both Slovakia and the Czech Republic." Tina's prayer requests are for camp July 20-26 where there will be Hungarian girls and their worldview camp Aug 10-16 where Jozef will be helping with the teaching of the young men who are coming to camp.

Lorow, Ken & Eileen - ABWE Director of Prefield Ministries

July finds the Lorows stepping into one of their busiest season of the year - and of the most exciting! Over the next few weeks they will be involved in key trainings and events that are essential to preparing missionaries for the field. They will be welcoming over 40 new missionaries to Missionary Orientation which marks the beginning of their journey with ABWE. (Note: while these new missionaries are at the trainings, their children and the MK Ministries leaders are here at NLC where the children also receive training along with games, crafts and fellowship with new friends. And, our own Tyler Ishler is interning at ABWE and is here with the MK Ministries.) "It's a joy and privilege to invest in them-helping them clarify their calling, understand our mission, and prepare for the path ahead. Please pray that each one would feel deeply encouraged, connected, and confident in God's leading as they begin this new chapter. Our prefield coaches and staff are working hard to walk alongside each of these candidates, helping them navigate the many steps between application and arrival on the field. It's a sacred re-sponsibility and one we don't take lightly." The Lorow's prayer requests are: 1) Strength and endurance during a full month of summer ministry activity; 2) For the 40+ new missionaries attending orientation-that they would sense God's peace and purpose; 3) For our prefielders in various stages of training and support raising; 4) God's favor and guidance in the ongoing process of selling our home and 5) For the Lorows to remain centered, rested, and expectant in all God is doing. "Thank you for faithfully partnering with us. Your prayers and encouragement truly make a difference, not only in our lives but in the lives of every missionary being sent out.'

Ivey, Mike & Jill - BBF Korea

The Iveys share this story from Mr. Ha... ` "Opportunity" during our men's Bible study, one of the brothers asked some sincere and heartfelt questions about how to repent of his sins, how to meet God, and how to truly know Jesus. In that moment, Pastor Mike encouraged him to receive Jesus Christ. Mr. Ha continues... "Passion" I was there and able to offer a small amount of support, but what impacted me most was the deep and genuine longing this friend showed. Seeing his desire to know Jesus stirred something in me - it challenged me to reflect on my own heart. I realized that just as he longed to know Jesus, I carry a longing to share Jesus, a passion for the gospel. Mr. Ha concludes... "Commitment" My prayer request is this: that his longing would become a spiritual challenge for me, fueling my own desire to proclaim the gospel. I want my passion for sharing Christ to grow stronger and deeper, led by the guidance of

the Holy Spirit. **This is why we serve...** One may prayed to receive Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior. The second man, Mr. Ha, was convicted of his own need to faithfully share the gospel. As you pray for us and the start of new congregations, would you pray for the next generation of laborers for the work?"

Serino, Nick & Darianne - Alaskan Arctic

The Whaling feast was in early June. The fruit of 14 whales was distributed over the 3 day feast! Nick & Darianne were called up to address the start of the 2nd day of the feast and to pray. "It was a blessing!" They thank God for "Dolly" trusting the Lord Jesus Christ as her Saviour. They ask that we pray for Dolly as she is battling cancer and has been experiencing complications. "Bobby", one of the teens was saved after a teen class. He had been coming for several months and finally decided he needed Jesus. "What a blessing! He has a good spirit and has started to come to evening services too." In early August the Serinos will be heading to Fairbanks for a week of doctor visits, etc. Afterwards they will head to Idaho, followed by NY, PA, VA, WV then Phoenix for Nick's check up at the Mayo Clinic on Oct 3rd. "After that we head back to Fairbanks and then back to Point Hope at the end of October. That's a lot of driving so please keep us in prayer as we visit at least 12 of our supporting churches." They ask that we keep praying for new missionary families to answer the call of God to Wainwright and Point Lay as they will be without pastors very soon.

Rizzo, Tony & Becky - Youth Action Ministries

The Rizzos update begins with Safety Zones. The Streets of Kensington Ministry in June "was a phenomenal time of sharing the gospel with many passersby! I was blessed by our team of associate evangelists and leaders how helped us share the good news and counsel the many people who stopped by to visit with us. Our food distribution was also a great success. Thank you for your faithful prayers covering this outreach." The recent Youth Safety Zone was "an incredible blessing! Our latest outreach saw upward of 60 students coming out to the Youth and Kids Safety Zone. I'm sensing that many students are hungry and in need of hearing the refreshing message of the gospel. I'm sure this is something they don't usually hear, and it's something that draws them in. Once again, several dozen students responded to our counseling invitations, trusting in the Lord as their Savior, and addressed other critical spiritual matters in their hearts." God is working through the YouthFluential ministry. The ministry is reaching souls across multiple platforms: "Our YouTube channels are touching 5,000 lives daily, and social media platforms are reaching 2,000 people every day. Our website ministry averages 6,000 views annually. These combined efforts are reaching over 2.5 million people yearly with the Gospel! In just 3 years, we've witnessed nearly 5 million views of content sharing Christ's message of salvation. And friends, this is just the beginning of what god has planned!" Please pray for Becky's ongoing health challenges as she learns to manage the ongoing pain. The virus she battled in 2024 has left a significant impact on her body. "Your prayers are deeply appreciated as she adjusts to these challenges and continues serving despite them."

Hawes, Tim & Leandra - ABWE Papua New Guinea

The Hawes begin with "God blessed the Bible club rallies on June 3rd - 5th with approximately 4,000 public school children participating, 240 professions of faith, and 146 public school teachers participating in the training. What a joy to watch the New Testament Church Pioneers from The Crown College and Temple Baptist Church pray earnestly, and see God answer their prayers so specifically as they worked so hard!" The Bible Club board met on June 19th & 20th. "It is so exciting to see the curriculum continue to spread across the country." A pastor recently texted that he saw 32 professions of faith in his school. "Please pray as our board members each follow up on different opportunities with local pastors, the education department and teacher colleges." The Hawes ask that we continue to pray for the Bible Clubs for revival, curriculum, funding, training and the follow up of salvation decisions. "A special thank you to our many prayer warriors, supporters, and logistics team.

Hoagland, Ed & Annita - BBF Mexico City

The Hoaglands begin with their thankfulness for the chances and opportunities that God continues gives them to share the Good News of Jesus with others. People are receptive to the message. They may not see thousands coming, but they are thankful for all the fruit He gives. Over the previous 2 weeks, the Manna Migrants ministry (where people live in little shacks next to some tracks) served 324 plates of food and saw 29 salvation decisions. The evangelistic

team won another 12 souls at the hospitals and their main church saw 5 more believe in Jesus as their Savior. The ministry to those 60 years of age and older continues to grow. The hope is that they will invest and share their wisdom with the next generation. The Hoaglands ask us to "Please pray for our Manna Mania team that will make an evangelistic presentation to 300 children and their parents on the 21st of this month. And for our summer evangelistic youth camps from July 28th until August 9th." They end with "Thanks for all you do to help us with all God is doing here in Mexico City. God bless."

Bennett, Dan & Becky - BIMI ARM Personnel (Assistance & Relief Missionary)

The Bennetts begin by sharing about a pastor for the Deaf church in Sao Paulo. "As we mentioned in our last letter, we asked that you continue to pray for a pastor for the Deaf church in Sao Paulo. Just last month, God answered our prayers and sent a pastor to the Bible Baptist Church for the Deaf in Sao Paulo! God miraculously worked and brought back a former pastor of the Deaf church that had already served there for 17 years. He and his wife have been away from the Bible Baptist Church for 12 years, and God answered our prayers in a tremendous way. THANK YOU to all who prayed with us about this!" The Bennetts recently spent 5 days at BIMI for Enrichment Week, a time set aside for missionaries on furlough to get enriched, revived, relax a little, be encouraged, and enjoy good fellowship with other missionaries. The Word was preached some timely messages that ministered to Dan & Becky in a special way. They were able to talk with other veteran missionaries about their new ministry and get some ideas, suggestions and direction for possible ministry opportunities. "It was a necessary time for us to get away for a few days as God confirmed to us that the need for more laborers to the Deaf is urgent and that God can use us to be instruments in showing this need to others. Although we are only in the beginning phase of this new ministry, we are excited about the possibilities of more people surrendering to Deaf missions."

Strayer, Hannah - ABWE Togo

Hannah begins with Romans 10:14a - "How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard?" She then shares the story of Jonas. "Jonas' grades were poor, and he was not engaged with the teaching. The issue was not one of intelligence or aptitude; Jonas was struggling because he had gone deaf 2 years earlier after being given too much medicine." In 2018 Liz Ortiz met Jonas while on a short-term trip. Her American Sign Language (ASL) skills were generally understood, so she used this knowledge to teach Jonas, his mother and his brother to communicate in sign. The change with Jonas was notable, but his school was not equipped to help him advance. As Liz returned to the US, Jonas began attending a school for the Deaf about an hour from his home. Liz found the burden for the Deaf in Togo would not leave her. She joined ABWE and eventually returned to Togo in 2024. 'A very crucial question that drives Liz's current teachings is "how does one share the truths of the gospel with those who cannot even communicate their emotions or recognize their own name?" Before she can share about sin and death and salvation, Liz must help the students understand basic language concepts in sign.' Liz continues the work on her own and is prayerfully seeking more people to join this ministry for how can they hear with no one to teach them? This month, Kristin DeVries, a teacher of the Deaf and Hard-ofhearing, is working with Liz at VBS, teacher training, and Deaf Camp. Hannah's praises are: 1) Kristin arrived safely, 2) Most of her furlough visits are set up and 3) All 4 VOL students passed the exams. Hannah's prayer requests are: 1) Liz & Kristin's events, 2) Kristin's return to Canada July 28th and 3) Hannah's final prep and packing.



The Shepherd's Staff Signifies Our Dependence On The Power Of God!

By faith Jacob, when he was dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph, and worshiped, *leaning* on the top of his staff. *Hebrews 11:21, NKJV*

⁷ And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. ⁸ Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. ⁹ And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. ¹⁰ Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. W. Phillip Keller, in his book "A Shepherd Looks at Psalm 23", comments on the uniqueness of the shepherd's staff: "In a sense, the staff, more than any other item of his personal equipment, identifies the shepherd as a shepherd. No one in any other profession carries a shepherd's staff. It is uniquely an instrument used for the care and management of sheep—and only sheep. It will not do for cattle, horses or hogs. It is designed, shaped and adapted especially to the needs of sheep."
